

<u>PowerTrip</u> is a new amazing App that has been developed in NZ that helps you plan everything you need for your journey in your EV.

Range anxiety is that feeling you get when your fuel gauge is in the red and you don't know where the next stop is. The Power Trip app uses map data, the physics of your car and your driving profile to estimate how much energy your car will need to get from A to B and which charging stops you'll need to make.

Once you've set up your driver profile, you just need to tell the app where you're going and it will work out the most efficient way for you to get there. If you need to stop somewhere specific on your journey, no sweat, just tell the app. It will also help you to find fun and delicious things to do while you're waiting to charge.

## **TODAY'S TRIP**

The suggested route for the first day on your epic road trip is to take the lesser driven road which has now been upgraded from a 4x4 dirt track to a beautiful and scenic pave road winding around the gorgeous bays of the Banks Peninsula.



From Christchurch to Akaroa, and back to Little River (the scenic route):

### 106 km, approx 2.5 hours

This distance will not require a midway charge. You can charge at SiloStay (with a Tesla charger adapter if you're in a Hyundai IONIQ) or you can plug in at the ChargeNet Fast Charger across the road - Click Here for all ChargeNet locations

Pohatu Penguin Tours & Sea Kayaking

Pohatu Penguins is a family-run business with a long-standing history of protecting the Korora (Little Penguin). The colony survival is accredited to the family who has cared for the penguins for 30+ years. Small group tours are offered from Akaroa over one of the most scenic back country roads to Pohatu/Flea Bay and Pohatu marine reserve, a beautiful sheltered bay out on the wild south eastern corner of Banks Peninsula and home to the largest Little Penguin Colony on mainland New Zealand with over 1500 penguins breeding there. See penguins up close and take part in their daily penguin monitoring program, discover unique native wildlife such as weta and geckos and support the conservation work as tours directly fund our conservation effort.

Tours include Evening penguin tour, Wildside Discovery tours, Sea-kayaking safaris, Hiking or a 24-hour package with a night in the middle of the colony.














### **VALLEY VIEWS GLAMPING**

They have endeavoured to make as little impact on the environment as possible by being completely off-grid, using solar panels for power in the communal building, choosing sustainable materials and eco-products wherever they can, recycling all that can be recycled, and they even have a worm farm septic system. Their 6 geodesic domes are equipped with everything you need to feel comfortable and pampered. The domes are furnished beautifully and they even have four outdoor private baths in the forest to really relax, unwind and enjoy the incredible night skies.



## **TODAY'S TRIP**

Driving from SiloStay in Little River to Valley Views Glamping near Kurow, we suggest you take the slightly longer route around Lake Tekapo; it's worth it for the spectacular views!

You will need to charge up in Geraldine, Fairlie (stop for a famous pie!) or in the beautiful surrounds of Lake Tekapo.

Drive 402 km, approx 4 hours & 55 minutes



It's a big day of driving today and you will want to get to Valley Views Glamping with plenty of time to soak up those views! You have many options for charging:

The historic Oliver's Lodge complex is situated in the gorgeous town of Clyde and opened a new chapter in its fascinating history when the building underwent an authentic restoration. The original stone complex, located in Clyde's historic precinct, was built by Benjamin Naylor in 1869 as a general store, servicing the prospectors who sought their fortunes during the Otago gold rush. Inspired by the past, owners Andrea and David Ritchie have sensitively restored the buildings including an elegant homestead, the old store, coach sheds, stables and barns.

There is a long history of winemaking with the region's industry pioneered in Clyde in 1895 by French immigrant Jean Desire Feraud. His Monte Christo wines won wide recognition. The Alexandra Basin, with over 20 producers, lies below the southern 45th parallel and to the south of all other Central Otago sub-regions. Soak in this extensive history with a wonderful tour of the vineyards.

## **RAINFOREST** RETREAT

Rainforest Retreat is situated at the heart of Franz Josef Village on the West Coast of New Zealand's South Island. Secluded but surrounded by a host of local activities and sights, it's the perfect base to explore and unwind. Nestled amongst native bush at the feet of the Southern Alps, Rainforest Retreat offers premium Tree Houses, Tree Lodges, Tree Huts and Park Motel accommodation, as well as a friendly and fun backpackers and holiday camp.

### What's GOOD?

Rainforest Retreat has a gold Qualmark certification for their enviro achievements. Some of the many initiatives they have implemented include using hot air from the exhausts from their commercial tumble dryers to preheat the water that goes into the commercial washing machines. They also use hot water heat pumps to heat their hot tubs, they have their own rubbish transfer station and compactor truck, they sort all of their rubbish onsite, and they recycle approximately 85% of all waste. One of the most visually obvious measures for guests is their milk, which comes in their own recycled glass milk bottles.





## ■ TODAY'S TRIP

From Camp Glenorchy to Rainforest Retreat, Franz Josef Drive 400 km, approx 5hs 30 mins







Your longest day of driving yet and there are no fast chargers between Lake Wanaka and Franz Josef yet. We highly recommend breaking up the trip with a night halfway if possible. After charging up in Lake Wanaka, you'll need to make two more charges because of the hilly west coast terrain. If you're in a Tesla, you can do this at the Heartland Hotel Haast and Lake Paringa Lodge. If you're in an IONIQ, the Heartland Hotel Haast charger is a Tesla charger only, so we recommend breaking up the trip with a night halfway. We also recommend a 'blue



# WEST COAST BACK TO CHRISTCHURCH

## TODAY'S TRIP

Drive 384 km, approx 5 hours & 9 minutes
From Rainforest Retreat, Franz Josef through Hokitika, scenic
Arthurs pass and back to Christchurch.

You will need to make a few stops to recharge today, if you drive from Franz Josef to Hokitika and **recharge at the New World Carpark**, ChargeNet fast charger you will have plenty of charge to get to the next charge point which is **Otira**. If you wanted, you could even take a detour to Hokitika Gorge for a gorgeous walk (see walks section for more info) and drive back around Lake Kaniere for a beautiful scenic route. To fit all of this in from Hokitika and to get to Otira is approx 180 kms. From Otira (another fast charger point) all the way back to Christchurch, it's 164 kms.

On this unique tour you will be able to find small pieces of Pounamu, learn to carve this precious stone into a necklace, and keep this taonga to cherish.









## SUGGESTED WALKS







### CHRISTCHURCH & BANKS PENINSULA

Christchurch and the Banks Peninsula have many wonderful walks on offer. The Port Hills are full of easy trails with wonderful views. Be like a local and walk up the Rapaki Track to the top to view the whole of the stunning Pegasus Bay.

A wonderful walk to do if you're looking for a good leg stretch during your scenic drive to Akaroa is the 'Little Mount Herbert' walk from the Port Levy Saddle. <u>CLICK HERE</u> for more information.

Another great place to walk is at Hinewai Reserve, a stunning area of regenerating native forest, this reserve is beautifully maintained with easy and moderate walks and incredible wildlife. <u>CLICK HERE</u> for more information.

### **SOUTH CANTERBURY**

On your way to Valley Views Glamping, you may wish to soak in the Mackenzie and Waitaki region with a few short walks. The Kurow Hill Walk is a 15 min drive from your accommodation and is a lovely quick 50 min return walk up to a seat with a great viewpoint over Kurow township. <u>CLICK HERE</u> for more information.

### **GLENORCHY**

Glenorchy is the gateway to so many wonderful walks. ### **WEST COAST**

## BEING A GOOD TRAVELLER




