JOB TITLE: Volunteer Team Leader, Appin Rainforest Regeneration Project

## **OVERALL PURPOSE OF JOB AND MAIN DUTIES**

The Volunteer Team Leader will lead the way in developing and delivering a volunteer programme as part of the Appin Rainforest Regeneration Project. Working alongside the Project Manager and Squad Team Leader the postholder will have lead responsibility for the recruitment, training and management of a volunteer team to help deliver an initial programme of volunteer activities that support delivery of the project and generate a wide range of community benefits.

It is envisaged that the role will become embedded for the long term as part of the planned delivery of the Appin Rainforest Regeneration Project and fundraising is in progress to secure this.

We are seeking a Volunteer Team Leader who is a confident communicator, able to engage effectively with the community both in person and online. The Volunteer Team Leader will enjoy motivating and inspiring others to achieve shared goals and be confident leading work parties. The aim is to ensure that every volunteer feels valued and supported.

The role will involve a wide range of activities including: development and delivery of an ARRP Volunteering Strategy and action plan; providing the central point of contact for volunteers; design and delivery of inclusive recruitment campaigns and training programmes; implementation of health and safety procedures; driving volunteer recognition and retention; maintaining records and producing reports.

Training will be provided including certificated training appropriate to the role.

**REPORTING** The Volunteer Team Leader will report directly to the Project Manager

Progress will be reported to the Board during Board Meetings.
