DRAWINS REQUIRED:

1. The drawing can be black and white on paper. It should show the size of the advertisement and its position on the land or the building, and relationship to adjoining properties and show all existing signs. In the case of a sign, it should also give the material to be used, fixings, colours, height above ground and where it would project from a building, the amount of the projection. The drawing should include the site location plan to scale, and should have sufficient details to enable the site to be identified.

OWNER'S CONSENT:

2. It is a condition of every consent granted by or under the Regulations:

That before the advertisement to which the consent relates is displayed; the permission of the owner of the land or other person entitled to grant permission shall be obtained.

OTHER CONSENTS:

3. Consent under the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1978 does not relieve the applicant from obtaining any other consents which may be necessary, e.g. under the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation Building Act and Regulations made there under.
