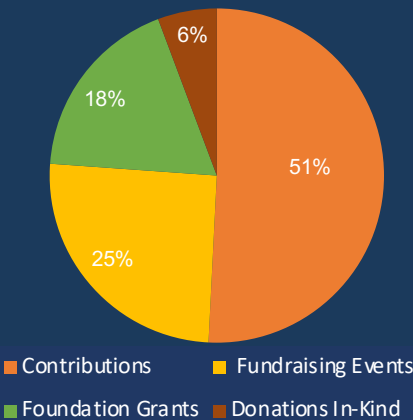

FY 2024-2025 Financial Report

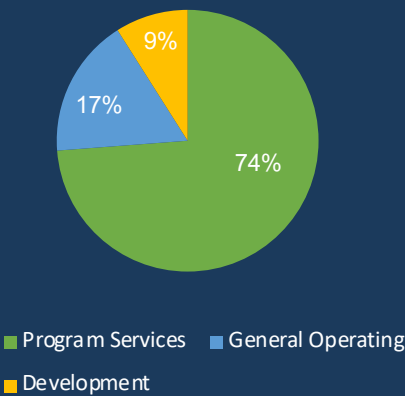
FY 2024–2025 was a year of responsible stewardship and continued investment in Malta House's mission. Thanks to the generosity of donors, foundations, businesses, and community partners, we sustained vital programs and services for mothers and children.

Total Expenses: \$2,329,307

During FY 2024–2025, 74% of Malta House's expenses directly supported program services, reflecting our strong commitment to investing in the mothers and children we serve. The remaining 26% funded essential administrative operations and fundraising efforts that ensure the long-term sustainability of our mission. Total expenses include a \$200,000 capital campaign receivable write off.

Before coming to Malta House, Kayshawna was determined to build a better future for herself and her unborn son. She was balancing school, work, and the challenges of pregnancy while pursuing her dream of becoming a special education teacher. But without stable housing or a reliable support system, that future felt increasingly uncertain.

Shortly after her son was born, Kayshawna lost her housing. With nowhere else to go, she packed the few belongings she could fit into her car, placed her newborn safely in his car seat, and drove away. For nearly a month, mother and son slept in their car while she searched for a safe place to live.

When Kayshawna learned about Malta House, it marked a turning point for both mother and son.

At Malta House, she found far more than temporary housing. She found stability, compassionate staff who believed in her, and case managers who helped her access resources, continue her education, and work toward independence. Most importantly, she found the confidence to keep moving forward.

Today, Kayshawna is continuing her education to become a special education teacher and is working toward a career with the New York City Department of Education. She is focused on creating a stable, loving home for her son and building a future they can both be proud of.
