



Transport of Firearms in Western Australia

Recent changes to Western Australia's firearms legislation (2025) have introduced updated requirements for transporting firearms in vehicles. When moving a firearm, it must be transported in a **rendered safe condition**. This means:

- The firearm must be **unloaded**.
- The **bolt** must be **removed, or a trigger/action lock must be fitted**.
- The firearm must be **secured in a locked container** that is not marked as containing firearms.
- **Ammunition must be stored separately** from the firearm.
- The **vehicle** must be **locked**, and the **firearm** must **not be visible** from outside the vehicle.

These requirements help ensure firearms are transported safely and securely in compliance with current legislation.
