Keys to Defensive Driving:

- Make sure you and your vehicle are prepared to drive
- Anticipate the other driver's next move don't be surprised by it
- Make driving your first priority



Practice Safe Behaviors:

- Keep focused on driving
- Realistically assess personal skill level and capabilities of your vehicle
- Stay cool and calm in stressful conditions
- Plan plenty of time for travel and adjust the way you are driving or the situation you are in
- Include the driving activity in your daily JHA/ ISEA
- Don't forget to use Stop Work Authority

Driving:

- Only use a vehicle that is fit for purpose and checked prior to use.
- Drive at a speed appropriate to the conditions and adhere to the road rules.
- Not use personal devices while driving except for hands-free navigation.
- Plan my journey to include regular breaks and fatigue checks.
