Emergency Action Plans-Medical Responses

- The Emergency Action Plan really covers the basics. Where and when to go, who to follow, how to get there, and how we make sure everyone's accounted for afterward.
- Evacuation routes and assembly areas shouldn't be something we're guessing about in the moment. They need to be known ahead of time and kept clear every day.
- If someone is injured or becomes ill, medical response comes first, documentation comes second.
- Authorized and trained personnel should take charge as needed.



Supervisor Roles in Emergencies

- Initiate evacuation when required
- Direct employees to assembly areas
- Account for employees
- Communicate missing or injured personnel
- Support emergency responders

Emergency Action Plan

- Evacuation routes and exits
- Assembly areas and storm shelters
- Emergency communication
- Accountability after evacuation

Bottom Line- Have a plan before you need it, make sure your teams know the plan and understands it, and review the plan frequently.
