Beginner Project Classes

"Handkerchief Vase" – Design and make your own handkerchief-style drape vase under the guidance of owner/tutor Elissa Beach-John. Popular class for beginners. One session \$130 pp. (Max. 8 students)

"Wall Posy Vase" New for 2026. Enjoy making and designing this sweet decorative wall vase with visiting tutor Laurie Rich. Intermediate Classes

“Fusing 101” – Recommended starter course for those wanting to learn the foundational basics of fusing glass including: cutting and preparing for the kiln, firing processes and a few different fusing techniques, all while creating some great projects for you to keep! Previously, we’ve run this course over three weekends, but are now operating over two full days attendance, inc. lunch. This intermediate course will provide you with a more in-depth knowledge of glass fusing and is **required for independent artist studio time as well as attending advanced classes**. Two sessions \$400 pp (inc. lunch both days); (Max. 4 students).

- March 21st, Saturday 11am – 5pm **AND** March 28th, Saturday 11am – 5pm. **OR**
- May 2nd, Saturday 11am – 5pm **AND** May 9th, Saturday 11am – 5pm

“Impasto” – Visiting advanced tutor, Cindy Cherrington, will be teaching this very unique, specialist technique using powdered glass, which is similar to the artists painting “impasto”, which uses a palette knife to thickly apply powdered glass mix to your glass panel, leaving visible marks and creating a textured, three-dimensional finish. Two sessions \$320 pp (Max. 8 students).

“Reactions Stage 1” – Recommended F101 Curriculum. In this two-part, two-day class, you will discover the critical basics of Bullseye glass reactions. Laurie Rich (VT) is renowned for her amazing, studied glass techniques and in this class you will learn all about how different glasses can react with others to create even more fused glass options. Students will create their own set of reference pieces as well as a final large project piece based on your preferred reactions choices. Two sessions \$420 pp (Max. 8 students).

“Cutting Wizardry” – Recommended F101 Curriculum. Recommended for EVERYONE, especially those with their own home studios. Laurie Rich (VT) offers this full day class where you will learn very advanced techniques to improve your hand-cutting skills – *without the use of power tools*. We strongly encourage all glass-workers take this course. One session \$280 pp (Max. 8 students).

“Frit Landscapes” – Cindy C (VT) will be teaching her stunning “frit painting” Landscapes technique. Create a 14” x 8” landscape piece in this advanced class. (Option to make a larger piece at additional \$\$-charge.) Sign up soon, this has proved a very popular class in the past and tends to fill quickly. Two sessions, two consecutive days, \$320 pp (Max. 8 students).
