Repeat Applicants (funding received within the last 24 months) Repeat applicants also follow a two-part process with two different deadlines. They must first submit an Intent to Apply or Letter of Intent (LOI) by the LOI deadline. The second step is submitting the full grant application by its deadline. Applicants who miss the full application deadline must wait 12 months before reapplying. Each cycle takes about six months and consists of LOI, full application, site visit, and grant award. The Fall Cycle LOI deadline is in mid-June, full application form in August (by invitation), site visit in the fall, grant award in early Dec., and grant report 18 months after the grant award. The Spring Cycle LOI deadline is in mid-Dec., full application form in February (by invitation), site visit in the spring, grant award in early June, and grant report 18 months after the grant award. When the agency's grant report deadline passes, they are eligible to apply again. Declined proposals may reapply at the next LOI deadline, but please email your regional Program Officer first for decline feedback. (2) The Foundation President reviews Initiative Grant LOIs on a rolling basis.
