



Being image bearers applied in three ways:

1. Dominion over the animals and earth.
2. Companionship with others.
3. Responsible beings who can be addressed by God and who are ultimately answer to God.

Being pro-life...

...believing the very best environment for children is to be conceived by and brought up in the home of their married male dad and female mom. Statistically, the safest place for an unborn child is in the womb of a married woman... nearly 90% of abortions are done on single women.

Being pro-life...

...is (believing) children are a gift from God, even those with special needs... pre-born babies diagnosed in utero with down syndrome are very likely to be aborted today—statistics range up to over 90% of those babies. God doesn't determine value based on how perfect a person is physically.

Being pro-life...

...believing life begins at conception and ends at natural death, that at the moment of conception, when the egg is fertilized by the sperm, that a new human being is created. All it needs is time and the right environment to grow—but it will never be more human than it is at the moment of conception.

Being pro-life...

...believing that anything that harms or destroys a human life, from conception on, is wrong, including Human embryonic stem-cell research, which requires the destruction of a human embryo for the research to be conducted.
