

SECTICS/MS PERSONNEL ORDINANCE #21, of August 1, 2025

THE SECRETARY OF SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, AND INNOVATION AND OF THE HEALTH ECONOMIC-INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX OF THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH, in the use of the powers conferred upon her by Article 68, Anexx I of the Decree #11,798 of November 28, 2023,

Considering the need to enhance the evaluation instruments for Productive Development Partnerships (PDPs), hereby decrees:

Article 1. A Working Group is hereby established, with an advisory mandate, to develop a monitoring and evaluation plan for PDPs within the scope of the Secretariat of Science, Technology, and Innovation and the Health Economic-Industrial Complex (SECTICS).

Article 2. The Working Group shall comprise principal and substitute representatives from the following units:

- I SECTICS's Office;
- II Department of Health Industrial Complex and Innovation (DECEIIS);
- III Department of Science and Technology (DECIT);
- IV Department of Pharmaceutical Assistance and Strategic Inputs (DAF);
- V Department of Management and Incorporation of Health Technologies (DGITS);
- VI Department of Health Economics, Investments, and Development (DESID).

Paragraph 1. The representatives shall be designated by their respective entities within five (5) business days following the publication date of this Ordinance.

Paragraph 2. The Working Group shall be coordinated by a representative of SECTICS' Office.

Article 3. At the discretion of the Working Group coordination, representatives of other units of the Ministry of Health, as well as other public-sector bodies and entities, may be invited to participate in meetings and provide technical input, in the capacity of consultants, without formally joining the Working Group.

Paragraph 1. The participation by the invitees referred to in the head provision of this Article shall be occasional and shall not entitle them to any form of compensation.

Paragraph 2. The contributions of such consultants may be incorporated into the Working Group's final report, at the discretion of its members.

Article 4. The Working Group shall have a period of one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of publication of this Ordinance to complete its work and submit a final report containing its proposals.

Article 5. Participation in the Working Group shall be deemed a relevant public service and shall not entail any additional compensation.

Article 6. This Ordinance takes effect upon its publication date.
