This one-day workshop will apply the current best practices in prescriptive and child-responsive play therapy to helping children in families where there is a high level of disruption and conflict among the adults, including divorce and custody conflicts. We will utilize the framework for prescriptive trauma-informed play therapy to develop a comprehensive treatment approach to promoting emotional and physical safety,

and providing opportunities for children to use the play therapy environment to improve their ability to cope with loyalty binds and begin healing. We will practice playful interactive assessments using puppets and consider examples of creative trauma narrative work that can be combined with other trauma protocols such as EMDR. We will also examine how to mobilize and include all the child's significant caregivers in their child's healing in this context, with close attention to the legal and ethical issues for the therapist, and a chance to apply these principles to the treatment plan of a current case.

Learning Objectives

1. Apply a phase model for play therapy treatment of the trauma experienced in a high conflict family to a current child case.
2. Describe a method of using puppets and play in a dynamic family assessment and treatment approach.
3. Describe the differences between cooperative and parallel coparenting and when each is best used with families.
4. Analyze the themes of a child client's play to amplify and suggest metaphors to gradually approach traumatic material related to the parenting system.
5. Distinguish the role of the play therapist within the legal system from that of other providers and articulate at least one ethical dilemma that play therapists face in these cases.
6. Describe expressive art and play-based trauma narrative approaches with child clients in the digestion of traumatic events which have occurred in high conflict and divorcing family systems

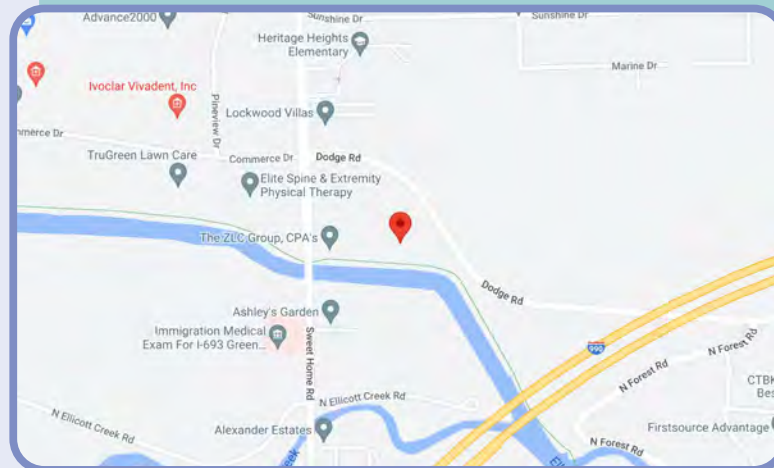
