Please join us for a presentation of “13 Drivers’ Licenses,” a traveling exhibit and educational project that details the 1938 Nazi confiscation of drivers’ licenses belonging to Jewish residents in Lichtenfels, Germany, shortly after the November Pogrom, also known as *Kristallnacht*. Following the discovery of the licenses, 80 years later, the local high school created a project to learn about the fate of the license holders.

In a partnership between the Somers Central School District, the Town of Somers and the Holocaust & Human Rights Education Center, this *Tusker Cafe* will feature a 45-minute presentation, followed by a Q&A and breakout session for group discussion.
