PROJECTS & PROGRESS

- The proposed **NYS Police Barracks project** continues to move through the approval process. The **WC Dept of Health** has provided preliminary approval of the subdivision application, with final approval anticipated following completion of the signed plans.
- Planning continues for the proposed extension of public water service through the **Route 202 Business Hamlet District and Somers Water District No. 2**. Outreach to affected property owners is expected to begin as the district formation process moves forward this summer.
- Progress continues on the **Reynolds House Well and Septic Project**, with regulatory reviews underway through the **NYS Dept of Environmental Conservation** and the **WC Dept of Health**. Approvals are currently anticipated by the fall.
- Community input continues to be compiled for the grant-funded **Reynolds House Master Plan**, which is expected to be refined and developed throughout the summer.
- A **site walk for the Reis Park project** is scheduled for **June 8**, as Town representatives and consultants continue advancing the design and planning process.
