### PROJECTS & PROGRESS

Summer is one of the busiest seasons for municipal projects and infrastructure work. Residents may see increased activity related to roadway improvements, engineering studies, utility projects, and park planning. The Town remains committed to advancing these projects while minimizing impacts on residents. Updates will be shared through Town Board meetings, newsletters, social media, and the Town website.

### TOWN UPDATES

- The Town has received an update from **NYSDOT** regarding the **Route 202/Warren Street Culvert Replacement Project**. The road closure and detour will now begin on **June 29, 2026**, earlier than the previously announced July 7 start date, allowing additional construction time before the school year begins. Detour signage and **Portable Variable Message Signs** will be installed in advance. The Town will continue providing updates as more information becomes available.
- Town departments are preparing for a busy summer season with recreation programs, park maintenance, roadway improvements, and community events. Residents are encouraged to follow Town communications for updates and announcements.
