### PROJECTS & PROGRESS

The Highway Department continues infrastructure improvements across Town. At West Somers Park, crews are completing drainage upgrades ahead of future paving work. Crews are also replacing a damaged drainage pipe on Mahopac Avenue to improve drainage and support roadway conditions. These projects reflect the Town's ongoing commitment to maintaining safe and reliable infrastructure for residents.

### TOWN UPDATES

The Town has received confirmation from the **NYSDOT** that the **Route 202/Warren Street Culvert Replacement Project** will now begin on **June 29, 2026**, earlier than the previously announced July 7 start date. The revised schedule provides additional construction time before the start of the school year.

As construction approaches, we want to clarify that **Route 202 will only be closed between Firemen's Field and Somers Middle School**. Through traffic will be detoured around the work zone, and residents are encouraged to follow the posted detour routes and traffic signage to help ensure safe and efficient travel throughout the project. Town officials will continue coordinating with NYSDOT, emergency services, and project stakeholders to minimize impacts on residents and keep the community informed as construction gets underway.
