INSIDE TOWN HALL | BEFORE THE BUDGET HEARINGS BEGIN

Work on the 2027 Town Budget is already underway, well before the formal budget hearings residents will see later this year. Supervisor Scorrano is meeting individually with each Town department head to review current spending, anticipated needs for 2027, and requests for equipment, personnel, programs, or other expenditures. These meetings provide an opportunity to ask questions early and understand not only what is being requested, but why, before those requests become part of the formal budget discussion.

Good budgeting starts long before the numbers reach the hearing room.
