

## Code of Conduct

### Scope

Flowtec Code of Conduct applies to, and must be respected and followed by:

All employees, hired personnel, and agents acting on behalf of the company, as well as suppliers, including their sub-suppliers, and customers of the company. In addition to Flowtec ethics principles.

### The Ten Principles of the UN Global Compact

#### Human Rights

Principle 1: Businesses should support and respect the protection of internationally proclaimed human rights; and

Principle 2: make sure that they are not complicit in human rights abuses.

#### Labour

Principle 3: Businesses should uphold the freedom of association and the effective recognition of the right to collective bargaining;

Principle 4: the elimination of all forms of forced and compulsory labour;

Principle 5: the effective abolition of child labour; and

Principle 6: the elimination of discrimination in respect of employment and occupation.

#### Environment

Principle 7: Businesses should support a precautionary approach to environmental challenges

Principle 8: undertake initiatives to promote greater environmental responsibility; and

Principle 9: encourage the development and diffusion of environmentally friendly technologies

#### Anti-Corruption

Principle 10: Businesses should work against corruption in all its forms, including extortion and bribery.

All parties in our supply chain must be open to review regarding these rights

#### Workplace Health and Safety

Everyone in Flowtec's supply chain must have a safe and healthy workplace in line with national laws and regulations

#### Trade sanctions

International and national trade sanctions apply. Products and services must not be bought from or sold to countries, companies, or individuals under trade sanctions.
