| Is the announcement material? |

| Does it reflect a significant change in the project's operations, technology, or value? |
| ☐ Has it been verified by a credible third party? |

| Is the disclosure clear and balanced? |
| Does it include measurable outcomes or just vague promises? |
| ☐ Is the tone promotional or informative? |
| Is there a history of follow-through? |
| ☐ Has this team or project delivered on previous announcements? |
| Do they publish timelines, roadmaps, or updates? |
| Does it look like independent reporting? |
| Was it covered by a neutral source or self-published and repackaged? |
| Can you verify the origin of the quote or article? |
| Are influencers promoting it without disclosure? |
| Do multiple posts use the same wording or go live at the same time? |
| Has any compensation been clearly stated? |
