Adopt the Skills Builder Universal Framework

The Skills Builder Universal Framework breaks down each essential skill into teachable steps, supporting all individuals' progress throughout their lives. The Framework was developed by Skills Builder with the Careers & Enterprise Company, Gatsby Foundation, Business in the Community and CIPD. It provides a shared language and outcomes for everyone in the Partnership.



How impact organisations use the Framework

There are 16 steps for each skill, allowing your organisation the flexibility to select which skills and steps are most useful for you to support your beneficiaries to develop.

- Learning outcomes
- Success criteria
- Monitoring and evaluation indicators



Skills Builder Impact Level Accreditation is awarded to partners who have successfully embedded the Skills Builder Framework into their provision. This reflects what impact your programme or provision has for your beneficiaries. For a complete overview of Impact Levels, view our Impact Guide.

During the Impact Programme, your Skills Builder Associate will work closely with you to set and prioritise your goals. After deciding which Impact Level(s) you would like to achieve, we will provide support and guidance to get there.



Once achieved, your programme or provision will feature in our Impact Directory. This is shared regularly with the Skills Builder Partnership network of schools, colleges and other partners, and contributes towards our collective impact mission.

Skills Builder Benchmark



Discover essential skills at an individual level

The Skills Builder Universal Framework breaks each essential skill into development stages and progression steps. This forms the basis for Benchmark's skills reflection tool, where individuals can make quick and easy reflections by independently answering some simple questions.

Offer targeted support

Benchmark admin licences allow your organisation to view the admin dashboard. This shows a summary of individuals' skills reflections, to enable targeted guidance and support. View collated data for groups of individuals, to understand skills strengths and gaps across your provision.

Measure your impact

View progress over time to understand your programme's impact at the individual level, or at group level.

- Single Sign On to streamline logging in
- Data sharing API to connect with your own data management system
