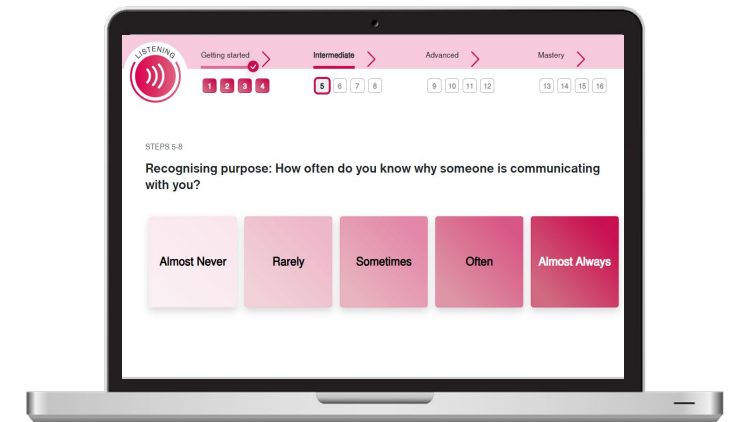
Skills Builder Benchmark

Online self-assessment platform for learners

- Skills Builder Benchmark can provide a snapshot of learners' current skill set and identify new areas for growth.
- Each skill is broken down into themes, and then smaller steps, so learners can make quick and easy reflections.
- Teachers can create groups for learners to join, allowing staff to track progress, pitch teaching, and offer coaching and interventions.
- Admins can oversee all staff and learners across the school or college, allowing for wide-scale interventions and progress reporting and celebration.
- On Impact - access to directed assessment, which allows you to narrow the focus, moving away from broad self-reflection to specific, intentional skill development.
- On Thrive - access to 360 assessment (add in teacher reflections on skill levels) and digital portfolios (learners can save written evidence and reflections about their skills journeys).

HOW MUCH DOES DIGITAL MEMBERSHIP COST?

Prices start at £490 for our Core tier, and go up to £1,995 for our Thrive tier. Choose the tier that matches your data and resource needs for the coming year.

HOW AND WHEN DO I APPLY FOR DIGITAL MEMBERSHIP?

Ready to get started? You can register for Digital Membership at any point throughout the year via our website [here](#). To keep things streamlined for schools and colleges, all memberships align with the standard academic year running from September through July.

Because our pricing structure is fixed for the year, we are unable to offer pro-rata rates, meaning the annual tier cost remains the same regardless of your start date. However, signing up at any point grants your team immediate, unrestricted access to all of your tier's platforms and resources for the remainder of that academic year.

WHEN WILL MY DIGITAL MEMBERSHIP START?

Your 2026-27 Digital Membership will run September 2026 – July 2027. Your programme automatically renews annually, and you will be sent your renewal options in the summer term.

WHAT SUPPORT IS AVAILABLE?

Digital Membership provides self-service access to your chosen platforms and resources. As part of your membership, you will receive regular programme emails, 3 x 30 minute support calls for technical queries and email support from our team all year round.

DO YOU PROVIDE CPD?

CPD is not a core part of our Digital Membership programmes, but we can offer CPD sessions for an additional cost.

CAN YOU HELP US PLAN OUR PROGRAMME?

Digital Membership is a self-service programme. Bespoke Support Time can be added on to your programme for an additional cost, which can be used to support planning, strategy, resource creation, data analysis and more.

If you want to explore a programme with a higher level of support, our Accelerator Programme offers 1:1 support from a dedicated Education Associate. The Accelerator opens for applications every spring term, and runs for the whole of the following academic year. You can find out more [here](#).

WHAT IS SKILLS BUILDER HUB?

Skills Builder Hub is our online teacher platform. It is designed for teachers, by teachers and gives you the tools and resources needed to successfully teach essential skills. It also features a group assessment tool, to measure your learners' progress.

HOW DOES THE ASSESSMENT TOOL WORK?

The assessment tool offers a quick and easy way to assess your class or group as a whole, so that you can pitch your skills teaching at the right level for your learners.

The tool saves all of your data over time, so you can see how much progress your class or group has made. It also recommends resources based on your assessment. People with Admin-level access can see the Data Overview, which shows the progress of all classes and groups across the whole school or college.

WHAT RESOURCES ARE ON THE HUB?

The Hub houses hundreds of resources, including short lessons (to explicitly teach the core ideas of each skill step), posters, certificates, skills passports, workshops, mini-apprenticeships, careers challenges and more. New to this year, we will be adding a whole extra level of resources, only available to those on a programme with us.

HOW DO WE USE THE HUB?

Hub has its own [Help & Training](#) section, which takes you through everything you need to know to get the most out of the platform. We also have a YouTube channel with an overview video [here](#).

WHAT IS A CHALLENGE DAY RESOURCE?

Best delivered off-timetable by classroom teachers, you can run it with multiple year groups at once or over separate days. In each Challenge Day, learners apply all 8 essential skills. See Challenge Days [here](#) on the Hub.

WHAT ARE PROJECT RESOURCES?

Best delivered over 10 hours, over a series of lessons. Work best in primaries and specialist settings. 24 themes, suitable for EYFS, KS1, KS2 and KS3. See Projects [here](#) on the Hub.

DIRECTED ASSESSMENT

Targeted skill scaffolding

Learners unsure of which skills and steps they should be focusing on? **Directed Assessment** allows you to narrow the focus, moving away from broad self-reflection to specific, intentional skill development. It's designed to help you align skill tracking with your existing curriculum, making progress both manageable for learners and visible for Ofsted or Gatsby Benchmarks.

360 ASSESSMENT

Individual teacher assessment

Self-assessment is a vital starting point, but teacher validation provides the professional rigor learners need. **360**

Assessment brings a second pair of eyes to the process, allowing educators to confirm a learner's proficiency. It's the ultimate tool for identifying learners who lack confidence (underselling their skills) versus those who may have a skewed perception of their current abilities. It closes the loop between how a learner sees themselves and how they are performing in the eyes of their teachers (and ultimately, a future employer). **360 Assessment** also allows you to ensure an accurate, staff-led data set, perfect for robust reporting and intervention.

DIGITAL EVIDENCE PORTFOLIOS

Capturing the 'lightbulb' moments

A skills score is a data point; a learner's reflection is a breakthrough. This feature transforms Benchmark from a tracking tool into a **Digital Skills Portfolio**. It empowers learners to articulate & evidence their own growth, helping them bridge the gap between 'doing an activity' and 'mastering a skill' - essential for future interviews and personal statements.
