VENUE

The Augusta County EXPO center will be the location of the festival, with 160 acres of land and over 50,00 square feet of indoor spots for vendors and vehicle display. Conveniently located near the intersection of I-81 and I-64 in western Virginia, getting to the festival will be a snap!

HOTEL AND DINING

The host hotel is confirmed! The Best Western of Waynesboro will be our “home base” for the 2026 event. Located just five miles from the Blue Ridge Parkway & Skyline Drive with countless wineries and breweries just minutes away. The Saturday evening banquet and vehicle judging awards will be in the ballroom of this hotel.

The hotel offers free Wi-Fi, is pet friendly, has an indoor pool and weight room, and free parking. Rooms are smoke-free and come with a full breakfast.

On one side of the hotel is a Cracker Barrel and on the other side is Fishin-Pig, the local family-run restaurant that is also hosting our Friday night “pig roast” at the EXPO event location. Numerous other eating establishments are also within walking distance.
