5 Kinds of Proverbs

- ① Where there is Divine Principle, there is Father.
Where there is Father, there is Divine Principle.
- ② Divine Principle is food for my spirit self.
- ③ Repentance prayer is air for my spirit self.
 - ⇒ Pure water and tears of repentance prayer.
 - ; The dirt of the physical self is washed with pure water.
 - ; The sinful dirt of the spirit self is washed with tears of repentance prayer.
- ④ Complaint and dissatisfaction is poison for my spirit self.
- ⑤ Those who live for myself go to hell and those who live for others go to the Kingdom of Heaven.
(Matthew 20:26-28)

Two kinds of functions of the Divine Principle

- ① The Divine Principle causes me to throw away satan's view of life and accept...

...God's view of life.

- ② The Divine Principle liberates me from being a slave of satan and causes me to become a child of God through daily life.

5 Kinds of satan

- ① Fallen archangel, fallen Eve, fallen Adam.
- ② Satan's evil king dynasty
- ③ Satan's evil "my ancestors"
- ④ Satan's evil "my parents"
- ⑤ Satan's evil "myself"
 - = child of satan
 - = son of vipers

5 Kinds of God's commandment

- ① Do not eat (Genesis 3:1-3)
 - ⇒ Do not commit sexual sin.
- ② Do not touch (Genesis 3:3)
 - ⇒ Do not embrace, kiss, massage or shake hands.
- ③ Do not look (Genesis 3:6)
 - ⇒ Do not look at others sexually or at sexual movies and magazines.

- ④ Do not think (Matthew 5:28)
 - ⇒ Do not think sexual daydreams and fantasies.
- ⑤ Do not think even in dreams (1 Corinthians 6:18)

Human history is guided by satan and God

- ① Satan guides and makes evil history through king dynasty (sovereignty).
 - ⇒ Kings have been committing the sins of adultery, murder, robbery, and have been against God.
 - ; In spite of this, every king pretends and declares that he is the son of God.
 - ; Through the elder brother, satan makes the king dynasty history, which is evil history.
We call this the elder brother's history.
 - ⇒ Satan's weapons are military weapons. Using military weapons satan takes the sovereignty and has been maintaining evil king dynasties.
- ② God guides and makes good history through religion.
 - ⇒ The main religion is Judeo-Christianity and the peripheral religions are Buddhism, Confusion and Islam.
 - ; God's weapons are blood, sweat, and tears and God uses these weapons through good persons who become martyrs.
 - ; Through the younger brother God makes the religious history, which is good history.
We call this the younger brother's history.

- ⇒ The younger brother tries to restore the elder brother's birthright.
- ; The younger brother represents Adam, who fell from being the Lord to become a servant.
- ; The elder brother represents the archangel who left his position of being a servant to become a lord.

PREDESTINATION

ⓐ The Predestination of God's Will

① What is God's Will?

God's Will = to realize the purpose of creation.

⇒ Due to the fall – Purpose of creation = purpose of salvation = purpose of restoration

② God's Will is predestined 100%.

⇒ Unchangeable and absolute.

③ God's Will is only good (never evil).

(Genesis 6:5, 6) – God felt repentance, sorrow and grief because of man's evil.

(1 Samuel 15:11) – God repented and grieved that He made Saul King.

(2 Samuel 24:16) – God repented for punishing the people too much.

^{also Jeremiah 18:8} (Jonah 3:10) – God repented of His intention to punish the people because they turned from their evil ways.

(Ezekiel 33:11-15) – God does not want to punish the wicked if they repent and change their evil ways.

(Exodus 3:7, 8) – God has sympathy for the Israelites and wants to take them from Egypt to Canaan.


⑥ God's predestination of the accomplishment of His Will

; God's Will = to realize the purpose of creation.

= to realize the purpose of salvation.

= to realize individual salvation.

1) By accepting God's Word through free will, human responsibility is fulfilled.

; By accepting satan's word through licentious will, human responsibility is failed.


2) Even the omniscient, omnipotent God cannot save mankind alone. God can only save mankind by the fulfillment of human responsibility. Therefore, mankind can receive salvation through the cooperation of God's 95% responsibility (God's Word not to eat from Messiah) and man's 5% human responsibility (learn, believe and practice).
; For man to receive salvation is for God to realize the purpose of salvation (purpose of creation).

② Bible Verses

- 1) (John 3:16) – Those who believe have eternal life.
- 2) (Romans 5:1) – By justification through faith, peace is produced with God.
- 3) (Ephesians 2:8) – Through faith you are saved.
- 4) (Matthew 7:7) – Ask, it will be given to you, – seek, you will find, – knock, the door will open.
- 5) (Revelation 3:20) – If you open the door, I will come to you.
- 6) (Mark 5:34) – Your faith has healed you.
- 7) (John 9:11) – Washed eyes and could see.
- 8) (James 5:15) – Prayer of faith can make the sick person well.

① Diagram



Notice ①

- 1) There are many Christian doctrines which explain that God predestines some people to go to Heaven and some people to go to hell. These doctrines are greatly mistaken. God never predestines anyone to go to hell. God only 95% predestines that everyone will go to Heaven.
- 2) However, according to 5% human responsibility man himself decides and chooses whether he will go to Heaven or hell.
- 3) We call these mistaken theories and doctrines foolish theories, wrong theories, poison theories, and evil theories.

Notice ② There are 3 kinds of prophets.


- 1) Formation stage prophets are the 4 major, 12 minor prophets and Elijah.
⇒ They were waiting for the first coming...

...of the Messiah

- 2) Growth stage prophets are the Christian priests and ministers, including the Roman Pope.
⇒ They are waiting for the second coming of the Messiah.
- 3) Perfection stage prophets are the True Parents Moonies.
⇒ They are witnessing to the second coming of the Messiah.

③ Condition for the predestination of the central person.

⇒ 95% condition

- 1) God's grace of the age
- 2) Merit of the chosen nation
- 3) Merit of the ancestors
- 4) Social (natural environment)
- 5) Personal ability, character, education

④ Clarification of the Bible verses indicating the doctrine of predestination.

① 95% + 5% Bible verses

1) (Romans 8:29, 30)

God > foreknew, predestined, called + justified = glorified
95% + 5% = 100%
(James 2:24)

2) Romans 9:13

Essau = Cain = archangel 95% (position)
Jacob = Abel = Adam

Jacob and Esau fulfilled their mission.

⇒ Fulfillment of mission ⇒ 5%

⇒ Receive blessing ⇒ 100%

; Comparison between Esau and Cain

Esau received the blessing

⇒ Fulfilled his mission (5%)

Cain was cursed (Genesis 4:7)

⇒ Failed his mission (5%)

② 95% Bible verses

1) (Romans 9:15) - God's mercy and compassion (sympathy)

⇒ (Exodus 33:19)

2) (Romans 9:21) – Potter can make any type of vessel using clay.

⇒ Always compare these two quotes with (Romans 8:29, 30) (Jeremiah 18:1-10)

③ Other examples of 95% + 5% Bible verses


1) (1 Corinthians 15:40) ⇒ When human responsibility is fulfilled, they receive their reward in the spirit world

2) (Matthew 13:3-10) ⇒ According to his ancestor's spiritual condition the nature of a person's spiritual mind is determined, as represented by the 4 types of land. If this person pays indemnity and separates from satan, he can change from evil to good land (spiritual mind).

⇒ Four kinds of land = hard road (path), rocky or small stone gravel covered with a thin layer of soil, thorn and weed with soil land, good soil land.

Desire requires joy and happiness



⇒ Evil desire requires evil joy and happiness

; Good desire requires good joy and happiness

Explanation

- ① The human mind has 3 functions\ul style="list-style-type: none;">- ⇒ intellect, will, emotion
 - ; the core of emotion is desire
- 1) I can gain God's Word or satan's word by the function of the intellect.
- 2) Intellect and desire are combined by the function of will.
- 3) When God's Word and desire are combined by the function of will, this desire becomes good desire.
 - ⇒ This function of will we call free will and human responsibility is fulfilled.
- 4) When satan's word and desire are combined by the function of the will, this desire becomes evil desire.
 - ⇒ This function of will we call licentious will and human responsibility is failed.

- ② Desire requires (pursues) joy and happiness through action.
- 1) Good desire requires good joy and happiness through good action.
- 2) Evil desire requires evil joy and happiness through evil action.
 - ⇒ This evil action we call committing sin.

3) When someone commits sin, this person absolutely receives punishment.

⇒ Where there is sin there is punishment.


; This phenomenon we call the law of indemnity or karma (James 1:13-15)

4) There are two kinds of important laws.

⇒ One is natural law which rules the natural world.

The other is the law of indemnity (karma) which rules human society.

Explanation

① God's value

- 1) God's Word is manifested in truth.
- 2) Good desire is manifested in beauty.
- 3) Good action is manifested in goodness.

② satan's value

- 1) Satan's word is manifested in falsehood.
- 2) Evil desire is manifested in ugliness.
- 3) Evil action is manifested in evil.

③ Three kinds of beauty and ugliness

- 1) Power (love) \Rightarrow true love and false love
- 2) Appreciation \Rightarrow beauty and ugliness
- 3) Value \Rightarrow beauty and ugliness

④ Three kinds of heart


- 1) mind

Notice ④ 4 kinds of desire, 4 kinds of social system and 4 kinds of sin.

a) First – desire to maintain existence

1) Desire to eat, desire to sleep, desire to wear.

⇒ These belong to natural law.

2) Economic system.

⇒ Mankind can gain food, shelter, and clothes through the economic system.

3) Sin of robbery.

⇒ Without material (money) mankind cannot exist.

When mankind gains material against the law, mankind commits the sin of robbery.

b) Second – desire to multiply descendants.

1) Desire for sex = sexual desire.

⇒ This belongs to God's commandment.

; Sexual desire is manifested in love.

2) Family system

⇒ Sexual desire or horizontal love is the essential power to keep and maintain the family.

3) Sin adultery

⇒ Without the family, mankind cannot exist.

When mankind realizes sexual desire against God's law of love, mankind commits the sin of adultery.

c) Third – desire to gain position.

1) Desire to dominate people by using the elder brother's position.

2) Political system

⇒ Mankind can exist by making communities through the political system.

; Political system absolutely requires the elder brother's position which is leadership.

3) Sin of murder

⇒ Where there is mankind, there is arrogance, resentment and hatred which produces the sin of murder.

; Without following God's elder brother's and younger brother's order, mankind commits the sin of murder.

d) Fourth – desire to gain knowledge

1) Desire to know the truth.

⇒ There are two kinds of truth.

; One is natural law and the law of indemnity.

The other is God's Word.

2) Thought system.

⇒ There are many kinds of organizations about education.

; God teaches mankind God's Word which is truth. Satan teaches mankind satan's...


...word which is falsehood through false theory, wrong theory, poison theory, and evil theory.

3) Sin of falsehood, disbelief and rebellion.


⇒ After the fall, mankind is educated and accepts satan's word, which is wrong theory and doctrine, through evil king dynasties which pretend to be the son of God.

Notice ④ My 4 kinds of satan's chains and my God's Divine Principle bridle.

② My 4 kinds of satan's chains



③ The Divine Principle is the Divine Principle bridle, which consists of a bit and reins.


⇒ Father, Jesus, and Heung Jin Nim willingly wear the Divine Principle bridle, bit, and reins.
; Wearing the Divine Principle bridle, bit, and reins means self-control.
; Without wearing the Divine Principle bridle, bit, and reins, nobody can enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

Notice ① The three proverbs which Father practiced throughout his whole life.



- ① To have self-control (to dominate, subjugate, conquer my desire) according to God's Word before I control the universe.
- ② In Father's daily life he would ask and pray to God and receive direction. According to this direction he would follow and live.
- ③ Father has been living for others (God's providence), not for himself, for his whole life.
⇒ Father 95% lives for others and 5% lives for himself.




Notice ⑬ Two kinds of function of Cain and Abel.

Explanation

[1] Fallen Adam exists in the midway position.

- Ⓐ God, as the Creator, has the right to dominate fallen Adam, but because God knows satan has a relationship with fallen Adam through blood lineage, God cannot insist on exclusive dominion over fallen Adam.
- Ⓑ Satan also has a right to dominate fallen Adam through the blood lineage, but because satan knows God is the Creator of Adam who fell, satan also cannot insist on exclusive dominion over fallen Adam.
- Ⓒ Therefore, fallen Adam exists in the midway position between God and satan.

[2] The reason why fallen Adam should be divided.

- Ⓐ According to the principle of Creation a being should be dominated by only one master.
- Ⓑ By falling, fallen Adam as one being was in a position to serve two masters. Therefore, fallen Adam became an unprincipled being.
- Ⓒ In order for God to make fallen Adam a principled being that serves only one master, God must divide fallen Adam into two beings, one serving God and the other serving satan.

[3] The method of division

Fallen Adam should be divided according to the course of Eve's fall.

ⓐ Eve fell into two kinds of illicit love: the first love with Lucifer, who is the unprincipled partner, and the second love with Adam, who is the principled partner.

; Explanation of the motivation of the fall.

(1 Corinthians 6:3) - mankind is master

(Hebrews 1:14) – angel (archangel) is servant

⇒ Cain and Abel are the fruits of love between Adam and Eve.

ⓑ Cain, as the first fruit of love (first son) between Adam and Eve, is the representative of the first illicit love between Eve and the archangel.

Therefore, Cain represents the archangel (Lucifer) and belongs to satan's side.

ⓒ Abel, as the second fruit of love (second son) between Eve and Adam, is the representative of the second illicit love between Eve and Adam. Therefore, Abel represents Adam and belongs to God's side.

[4] Abel's offering was accepted by God

ⓐ Abel, as the second son, belonged to God's side according to the division by the course of Eve's fall.

- ; Therefore, Abel's offering was accepted by God.
- ⑤ Also, as the representative of Adam, Abel can go directly to God because Adam, as the Lord, can go directly to God.
- ; Therefore, Abel's offering was accepted by God.
- ⑥ Abel should offer his sacrifice in the name of Cain, not his own name, like Jacob did in Esau's name.

[5] Cain's offering was rejected by God.

- ⑦ Cain, as the first son, belonged to satan's side according to the division by the course of Eve's fall.
- ; Therefore, Cain's offering was rejected by God.
- ⑧ Also, as the representative of the archangel, Cain cannot go directly to God because the archangel as the servant cannot go directly to God but can only go to God indirectly through Adam.
- ; Therefore, Cain's offering was rejected by God.
- ⑨ Cain should reject satan's dominion through separating from satan.

[6] The gate for Abel to go into the Kingdom of Heaven is opened by Abel bringing Cain.

- ⇒ Abel can only go to God by bringing Cain.
- ⑩ Why should Abel as the younger brother gain (restore) the elder brother's position?

- ① **Abel** and the relationship between Adam and the archangel.
 - ⇒ After the fall, Adam as the lord became the servant and the archangel as the servant became the lord.
 - ; Therefore, fallen mankind, who are fallen Adam, are dominated by the fallen archangel, who became satan, through evil king dynasties.
- ② **Abel** and the relationship between the younger brother and the elder brother.
 - ⇒ Abel as the younger brother belongs to God's side according to the order of Eve's fall.
 - ; The way that fallen Adam as the servant returns to his original position as the lord is the way that Abel as the younger brother should return to become the elder brother.

⑤ Abel's tactics and strategy and Abel as the younger brother returns to become the elder brother.

- ① Abel's tactics and strategy
 - 1) Abel established and maintained religious history by paying sweat, tears, and blood through which religious people became martyrs.
 - 2) Abel represents religious people who received persecution and were killed and their...

...property was seized by the evil king dynasty.

- 3) According to the law of indemnity (reward) Abel received punishment and paid indemnity without committing any kind of sin.
 - ⇒ Finally, Abel should receive grace (benefit) and blessing from God as a reward for his good actions.
- ② Abel as the younger brother returns to become the elder brother.
 - ⇒ When Abel becomes a dead martyr, he fails in his mission. When Abel becomes a living martyr, like Isaac, he succeeds in his mission.

; Abel can succeed by making the following conditions like Jacob and Joseph did.

- 1) Abel should receive punishment from the enemy elder brother without having committed any kinds of sin.
- 2) Abel should not have complaint or resentment during the time of receiving punishment.
- 3) Abel should even love the enemy, the elder brother.
- 4) Finally, Abel should give all things to the enemy, the elder brother.
 - ⇒ Through establishing these 4 conditions, Abel...

...should guide and educate the enemy elder brother Cain and through this Abel can make Cain obey, follow, and serve Abel willingly.

; Finally, Abel as the younger brother can return to become the elder brother.

⇒ In fact, Abel did not make these 4 conditions and according to this reason Abel did not restore the elder brother's birthright.

[7] The gate for Cain to go into the Kingdom of Heaven is opened by Cain following Abel.

⇒ Cain can only go to God through Abel.

ⓐ Why should Cain as the elder brother gain (return to) the younger brother's position?

① Cain and the relationship between the archangel and Adam.

⇒ After the fall, the archangel as the servant became the lord and Adam as the lord became the servant.

; Therefore, the archangel who became satan as the lord came to dominate fallen mankind by making evil dynasties.

② Cain and the relationship between the elder brother and the younger brother.

⇒ Cain as the elder brother belongs to satan's side according to the order of Eve's fall.

; The way that the fallen archangel as the lord returns to his original position as the servant is the way that Cain as the elder brother should return to become the younger brother.

ⓑ Cain's tactics and strategy and Cain as the elder brother should become the younger brother.

① Cain's tactics and strategy

- 1) Cain established and maintained evil king dynasties by using military power.
- 2) Cain as an evil king persecuted and killed religious people and seized property from the religious people by using military power.
- 3) According to the law of indemnity, Cain received punishment and paid indemnity for the sins he had committed.

⇒ Finally, Cain should meet his end through being destroyed and perishing.

② Cain as the elder brother should return to become the younger brother.

⇒ The way for Cain to leave and resurrect from the situation of having been destroyed and perishing.

- 1) First, Cain should turn and change his evil direction 180° through confessing his sins to others, repentance prayer to God and paying indemnity.
- 2) Secondly, Cain through these 3 methods should separate from, divorce from, and liberate himself from satan and arrive back to the point where he had originally gained satan's word.

- 3) Thirdly, Cain should destroy his evil desire through rejecting satan's word.
- 4) Fourthly, through destroying evil desire, which is satan's fortress, Cain should destroy evil habits, and the 4 kinds of fallen natures.
 - ⇒ Through passing these 4 stages Cain can come to follow Abel willingly.
 - ; Finally, Cain as the elder brother can return to become the younger brother.
 - ⇒ In fact, Cain did not pass through these 4 stages and according to this reason Cain could not return to become the younger brother and instead of this he killed Abel.

Notice

① Adam's family

Abel is killed by Cain.

② Noah's family

Cain (all mankind) is killed by the flood judgement.

③ Abraham's family

Jacob and Esau both were not killed.

④ Moses' course

Cain (Israel people) and Abel (Moses)...

...both are killed in the wilderness.


⇒ Cain (second generation Israel) and Abel (Joshua) both were not killed.

⑤ Jesus' course


Cain (John the Baptist) and Abel (Jesus) both were killed.



Foundation of Faith

[1] Noah's Foundation of Faith.

ⓐ Noah should separate from sexual satan's word to eat through controlling his sexual desire and should reach perfection by learning, believing, and practicing God's Word not to eat.
⇒ 10 generations - 1600 years (Adam to Noah).

Noah is the second human ancestor and the first ancestor of faith.

Noah believed God for 120 years. (40 years x 3).

⇒ Noah received persecution from the people, rejected satan's word and seduction, and educated his family.


⇒ Noah's family entered into the Ark, which was made by Noah.

ⓑ 40 days and the ark.

① 40 day flood judgment.

40 = 4 position foundation x 10 generations.

⇒ This was lost until Noah's time.




② The ark with 3 decks represents New Eden in


③ Raven and 3 doves

ⓐ Ham's failure



⇒ Noah's time ⇒ After 40 day flood judgment, they should feel as before the fall (no shame), but Ham felt as after the fall (shame about Noah's nakedness). Ham should have restored this, but Ham failed.

⑤ Ham's foundation of faith.

⇒ Ham did not inherit Noah's foundation of faith.


; Ham did not separate from satan because of his failure concerning Noah's naked body.

Therefore, Ham did not establish his own foundation of faith.

⇒ According to this reason, how could Ham start to establish the foundation of substance?

[1] Foundation of Faith

ⓐ Abraham's foundation of faith.

a) Abraham should separate from sexual satan's words to eat through controlling his sexual desire and should reach perfection by learning, believing, and practicing God's Word not to eat.

① Comparison of Noah and Abraham

Noah \Rightarrow 10 generations x 40 days \Rightarrow first ancestor of faith \Rightarrow second son /Ham

Abraham \Rightarrow 400 years \Rightarrow second ancestor of faith \Rightarrow first son of Terah (idol maker)

② Chaldea (Ur) \Rightarrow Haran \Rightarrow Canaan

(Iraq) (Syria) (Israel)

Genesis (12: 1)

\Rightarrow Abraham threw away his hometown, became a beggar and entered Canaan.

③ Canaan \longrightarrow Egypt \longrightarrow Canaan (Genesis 12:10)

\Rightarrow The archangel had a relationship with Eve while Adam and Eve were brother and sister, but the Pharaoh did not have a relationship with Sarah while Abraham and Sarah were brother and sister.

; Sarah restored Eve's fall.

④ Canaan → Gerar → Canaan.

Genesis (20: 1)

⇒ Abraham failed in the 3 offerings so he had to restore the fallen action of Adam, Eve, and the archangel again. Abraham, Sarah, and Abimelech did this.


b) Abraham and Sarah's faith.

① Abraham separated from satan by rejecting his worldly possessions, his hometown and his relatives by keeping God's Word to leave Ur and by receiving suffering in the desert (no food, house, or comforts).


② Sarah went into the king's palace, but she rejected a lavish life as a queen (fine jewelry, clothes and food) overcame the adulterous seduction and faithfully returned to her life as the wife of a beggar husband.





- ⑯ The division of the 3 offerings. (Genesis 15:9)
 - ⇒ Abraham separated from sexual satan through giving his wife Sarah to the Pharaoh and made the 3 offerings.



(Judges 14:18) – Without my heifer you would not solve my riddle.
– heifer \Rightarrow virgin, bride, wife.

Explanation ②

① When did Adam and Eve fall?

⇒ Adam and Eve fell at the top of the growth stage of the growing period.

- 1) God showed to mankind that Abraham's offering consisted of pairs in the formation and growth stage, but in the completion stage the offering consisted of a single being, a heifer.
- 2) This means that Adam and Eve reached the top of the growth stage as a pair (couple), but because of their fall they did not pass into the completion stage of the growing period as a pair (couple).

② Jesus inherited Adam's mission

1) Jesus came as a dove and succeeded in his formation stage mission representing the Old Testament age.

⇒ Jesus as a dove should restore Adam's formation stage failure and Abraham's formation stage offering failure.

2) Then Jesus came as a lamb and started his growth stage mission representing the New Testament age.

- ⇒ Jesus as a lamb should restore Adam's growth stage failure and Abraham's growth stage offering failure.
- ③ Jesus came as a bridegroom.
 - ⇒ Bridegroom needs a bride.
 - 1) Who should become the bride?
 - ⇒ After the fall, all women (sisters) should become the bridge to the Messiah Jesus Christ.
 - ; virgin (Matthew 25:1-13)
 - bride (Revelation 21:9)
 - wife (Judges 14:18)
 - heifer ⇒ virgin, bride, wife
 - 2) Then what should all men (brothers) become?
 - ⇒ All men should become the restored archangel.
 - ④ At the top of the growth stage according to God's providential history of restoration through indemnity, restored Adam, restored Eve, and the restored archangel should appear.
 - 1) The Messiah Jesus Christ, who is the restored Adam, appears as the bridegroom.
 - 2) All women, who are restored Eve, should appear as the bride.
 - 3) All men, who are the restored archangel, should appear as the son of the bride who is in the position of mother.

⑤ Why did the blessing given to Abraham change to a curse?

1) Abraham did not cut the dove and the pigeon of the 3 offerings; therefore, birds of prey descended upon the carcasses of the dove and pigeon.

2) Because Abraham did not cut the dove and pigeon he received a curse and punishment instead of blessing.

⇒ For 400 years the Israelites were sojourners, slaves, and oppressed in a foreign land.

Explanation ⑬

- ① The meaning of the 3 offerings.
 - ⇒ The creation (cosmos) consists of 3 stages in the growing period.
 - = All mankind and all things
 - = All mankind and half of the offering + Abraham and the other half of the offering.
- ② The meaning of dividing the offering.
 - ⇒ Fallen Adam exists in the midway position between God and satan.
 - ; By dividing the offering, all mankind and half of the offering belonged to satan, and Abraham and half the offering belonged to God
 - ⇒ By dividing the offering, the blood of death is purged.
- ③ The meaning of not dividing the offering.
 - ⇒ No part of the offering can be taken by God.
 - ; Therefore, satan takes all of the offering (all mankind and half of the offering + Abraham and half of the offering)
 - ⇒ The blood of death is not purged.

- ④ The birds of prey and the dove.
 - ⇒ Birds of prey symbolize satan (archangel). The dove symbolizes Adam. Birds of prey descending on the offering means satan dominates Adam.
 - ⇒ By not dividing the offering, Abraham did not provide God's part (to be offered). ; Therefore, satan claims and takes this offering, including the part meant for God.
- ⑤ Two kinds of results.
 - 1) Abraham did not establish the foundation of faith.
 - 2) Therefore, Abraham and his descendants receive a curse instead of a blessing. As a result, his descendants went to Egypt to suffer for 400 years as sojourners, slaves, and oppressed people in a foreign land.

In Adam's family → archangel and Adam



© Abraham's success in the offering of Isaac and Isaac's foundation of faith.

a) Abraham's success in the offering of Isaac.

⇒ The division of Isaac. (Genesis 22:1)



① The basis upon which Abraham is allowed to make a second offering.

- 1) Abraham's time is characterized as the completion stage, just as Adam's time and Noah's time are characterized as the formation stage and growth stages, respectively. Therefore, by Principle, Abraham has a condition for success in God's providence. (completion stage is the perfection stage).
- 2) Also, satan took the 2 generations of Adam and Cain. Therefore, God has a condition (qualification) to restore the 2 generations of Abraham and Isaac.

② The reasons for Abraham's success in his offering of Isaac.

- 1) Abraham's absolute faith and loyalty formed a reciprocal base with Isaac's absolute obedience. Through this reciprocal base, the power of give and take action was produced.
- 2) As a result of this good power of give and take action, Abraham separated satan from Isaac.
- 3) Abraham and Isaac both become living martyrs.

③ The results of Abraham's success in his offering of Isaac.

- 1) A person who failed in God's providence cannot carry on with the mission for God and cannot pass on the mission to any successor.
- 2) Abraham, who failed in the division of the 3 offerings, succeeded in the division of the offering of Isaac. Through this, Abraham restored his position as if he had succeeded in the division of the 3 offerings.
- 3) Therefore, restored Abraham can pass on (transfer) God's providence to Isaac.

b) Isaac's foundation of faith

- ① Isaac inherited Abraham's foundation of faith through his willingness to give his...


...life as an offering.

- ② Isaac, with Abraham, established his foundation of faith by offering (sacrificing) a ram. (Genesis 22:13)


[2] Jacob's foundation of faith and substance

ⓐ Jacob's foundation of faith

- a) Jacob inherited Abraham's and Isaac's foundation of faith.
 - 1) Jacob himself established the foundation of faith by learning from and resembling Abraham's and Isaac's foundation of faith.
 - 2) Jacob should separate from sexual satan's word to eat through controlling his sexual desire and should reach perfection by learning, believing, and practicing God's word not to eat.



3) Because of Abraham's failure, Ishmael was taken by satan. Today Arabs (Ishmael) attack the Jewish people.



b) Conditions for Jacob to establish

- ① Abel made his offering in the younger brother's name, but Jacob made his offering in the elder brother's name.
(Genesis 27:18-29)
- ② Jacob received the elder brother's birthright () through a sworn agreement in exchange for bread and lentil stew.
⇒ (from Esau)
(Genesis 25:29-34)
- ③ Jacob received the elder brother's blessing () using 2 "kids" (baby goats)
⇒ (from Isaac)
; Mother - son cooperation
(Genesis 27:5-17)

; Rebekah's faith

(Genesis 26:6-11)

④ Jacob received the blessing of wives and 12 children in Haran ().

⇒ (from Laban)

(Genesis 28:1-4; Genesis 29:30, 31)

; The last son, Benjamin, was born in Canaan.

(Genesis 35:16-19)

; Jacob - fiancées (waited 7 years)

⑤ Jacob received the blessing () through a wrestling match at the ford of Jabbok, a branch of the Jordan River.

⇒ (from the angel

(Genesis 32:24-28)

; The angel touched the socket of Jacob's hip so that his hip was wrenched.

(socket in the pelvis for the thigh bone)

; Jacob paid the indemnity condition for the sin of Adam's fornication.


⑥ Jacob overcame 21 years of persecution and suffering.

(Genesis 31:38, Genesis 29:18)

1) Jacob became the slave of Laban, receiving a course of suffering and persecution.

2) Laban deceived Jacob 10 times about property (wages)
(Genesis 31:40,41)
; Laban deceived Jacob once about his daughter.
(Genesis 29:25)

3) Laban (satan) deceived many times for his own desire and purpose while Jacob deceived only one time according to God's purpose, under his mother's guidance.
; Even though he followed God's guidance, Jacob still had to pay indemnity for his deception.



⑤ b) Jacob's foundation of substance

a) Esau's jealousy and resentment and Jacob's love for his enemy.

① Esau shot arrows at a drawing of Jacob every day for 21 years. Esau had jealousy and resentment because Jacob stole the elder brother's birthright. (Genesis 27:41)

② 21 years later, Esau prepared to kill Jacob with 400 armed followers, when they first met one another (Genesis 33:1)

③ Jacob prayed to love his enemy (Esau) every day for 21 years, while Esau prepared to kill him.

⇒ After crossing the Jordan River, Jacob met Esau and gave him servants, all things (animal property) and bowed down to Esau 7 times. (Genesis 32:13-21; 33:3)

⇒ Animal property are female and male goats, ewes and rams, female camels and their young, cows and bulls, female and male donkeys.

④ Esau could not kill Jacob because Jacob's power to love was stronger than Esau's power to kill.

⇒ Jacob's love for his enemy melted Esau's jealousy and resentment (Genesis 33:4)

b) Jacob restored the elder brother's birthright through subjugating satan who is the elder brother Easu.

① During the 21 years, Jacob established the foundation of faith.

1) Jacob separated from sexual satan by rejecting satan's word to eat.

2) Jacob learned, believed, and practiced God's word not to eat.

⇒ In other words, Jacob lived according to God's Word.

; Jacob willingly wore the "God's Word bridle" on his desire.

; Jacob controlled his desire through God's Word.

② Jacob educated and guided Esau to accept and follow God's Word by Jacob making the following 4 conditions:

1) Receiving punishment from the enemy elder brother without having committed any kinds of sin.

2) Not having any complaint or resentment during the time of receiving the punishment.

3) Even loving the enemy, who is the elder brother.

4) Giving all things to the enemy, who is the elder brother.

③ Jacob first established the foundation of faith. After this, Jacob made Esau establish the....

...foundation of faith.

- 1) Esau as the elder brother receiving Jacob's education and guidance establishes the foundation of faith, which consists of separating from sexual satan and reaching perfection by God's Word.
- 2) Because Esau as the elder brother has established the foundation of faith, he willingly decides in his mind to obey, follow and serve Jacob as the younger brother.
- 3) Therefore, Jacob can have the ability to make Esau obey, follow, and serve him.


④ Finally, Jacob could restore the elder brother's birthright through subjugating satan (Esau)

- 1) Jacob, as the younger brother, became the elder brother, and Esau, as the elder brother, became the younger brother.
- 2) Through Jacob's restoration of the elder brother's birthright, Jacob could subjugate (satan) for the first time in history.

© Foundation for the Messiah

- ① Abraham's providential purpose was fulfilled through Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph
 - ⇒ Joseph, instead of Jacob, fulfilled 4 kinds of conditions (separate from satan and subjugate satan) and then he became the Prime Minister of Egypt.
 - ; After this, their descendants became slaves and received suffering and persecution for 400 years (because Abraham did not divide the pigeon and dove.)
- ② If Abraham had succeeded in the 3 offerings, his descendants would not have had to go to Egypt. They could have stayed in Canaan 400 years and established a nation of God's sovereignty. Then Moses would have appeared and welcomed the Messiah.
- ③ God could not send the Messiah at Jacob's time because satan's side had nations and sovereignty while God's side only had a family foundation for the Messiah. (If God had sent the Messiah, satan's king dynasties would have killed him.)
- ④ Jacob's foundation was the family level foundation for the Messiah. Therefore, God had to wait until the national level foundation for the Messiah could be established.

Foundation of faith and substance



Foundation of faith

ⓐ The process to become a child of God.

① When I become a child of God, what kind of person will I be?

⇒ I will:

- 1) become a Temple of God
- 2) resemble God's divine nature
- 3) be in oneness with God

② How can I become a child of God?

⇒ I can become a child through establishing the foundation of faith which consists of:

- 1) separating from satan
- 2) reaching perfection

③ How can I separate from satan?

⇒ I can separate from satan (rejecting satan's word to eat) through destroying my evil desire (satan's fortress) which caused me to make the 4 fallen natures by which mankind has been committing the 4 kinds of sins.

④ How can I reach perfection?

⇒ I can reach perfection (I can perfect my personality):

- 1) By learning, believing, and practicing God's Word not to eat.

- 2) By living according to God's Word (Divine Principle)
- 3) By willingly wearing the Divine Principle bridle.
- 4) By controlling my desire (self-control) according to the Divine Principle.

Notice ① Child of God and child of satan.

① Child of God

⇒ I can become a child of God through living according to God's Word (Divine Principle) by free will in which human responsibility is fulfilled.

② Child of satan

⇒ I can become a child of satan through living according to satan's word (self-centered thought and desire) by licentious will in which human responsibility fails.

Notice ② Divine Principle bridle

① As man controls a horse by using a bridle, which consists of a bit and reins, God also controls mankind by using the Divine Principle bridle, which consists of a bit and reins.

② Mankind makes the horse's bridle and also subjects the horse to wear it.

On the other hand, God only makes the Divine...

...Principle bridle, but God cannot make mankind wear it. (James 3:2-4)

③ Then who can make mankind wear the Divine Principle bridle?

It is only possible for mankind to wear the Divine Principle bridle by fulfilling human responsibility.

Notice ④ Self-control

① Those who can control my desire according to the Divine Principle can go to the Kingdom of Heaven. On the other hand, those who cannot control my desire according to the Divine Principle go to hell.

② I should control my desire before I control the universe.

⑤ How can I destroy my evil desire (satan's fortress)?

⇒ My evil desire invites satan into me.

; Through this evil desire I become a child of satan (satan's slave) and, therefore, satan comes to dominate myself.

a) Method to destroy my evil desire.

① I can destroy my evil desire through self-denial and self-sacrifice, which is coming into the furnace.

⇒ self-denial – (Matthew 10:35-37)

self-sacrifice – (Matthew 10:38; John 12:25) (Luke 14:26; Mark 8:34) – both

② Melting furnace – method to separate iron and stone in iron ore.

b) Contents to destroy my evil desire

① To confess my sin to others and repent of my sin to God.

1) Through confessing my sin to others and repenting of my sin to God I can destroy my evil desire so that I can separate from, divorce from, and be liberated from satan.

⇒ As long as I hide my sin without confessing it and repenting, I can never destroy my evil desire. Therefore, I can never...

...separate from, divorce from or liberate myself from satan.

- 2) John the Baptist, Peter, Paul, and Jesus taught mankind that everyone should confess his sin and pray to God in repentance. (Matthew 3:2, 6; Mark 1:4, 5 and Matthew 4:17)
 - ⇒ Heung Jin Nim, who came back from the spirit world through returning resurrection, first taught us in the confession ceremony of the Blessed families that everyone should confess his sin to others and pray to God in repentance.
- ② To pay indemnity or to receive punishment for my sin is God's blessing and education for me.
 - ⇒ The contents of punishment is suffering, torture and martyrdom (punishment by death).
 - 1) Through paying indemnity or receiving punishment, which is God's blessing and education, I can destroy my evil desire which is satan's fortress, satan's building and satan's paved road.
 - ⇒ Without destroying satan's fortress, satan's building and satan's paved road (by jackhammer) I cannot make God's fortress...

...God's building and good soil which can receive God's word.

- 2) By paying indemnity and receiving punishment I can destroy my evil desire so that I can separate from, divorce from, and liberate from satan.
⇒ Therefore, receiving punishment is paying the consolation money (alimony) to separate from, divorce from, and liberate from satan.

Notice ② Natural law and the law of indemnity.

① Natural law

- 1) The natural phenomena of all things and the biological person can be explained by natural law.
- 2) Natural law consists of cause and effect which is causality.
- 3) Natural phenomena includes existence, actions of the mineral kingdom and life, multiplication activities of the plant kingdom, animal kingdom and mankind.

② Law of indemnity

- = Law of retribution
- = A reward in accordance with a deed
- = Retributive justice in the universe
- = Karma

- 1) Evil desire invites satan
 - ⇒ According to evil desire and satan, mankind commits sin.
 - ; Once you commit a sin, you will surely receive punishment for it (James 1:12-15)
- 2) When you yourself don't receive punishment for your sin, your children and your descendants will surely receive the punishment for your sins.
(Law of returning resurrection)
- 3) An evil person wants to commit sins and make his children and descendants receive the punishment.
- 4) On the other hand, a good person willingly wants to receive punishment for his sin with gratitude, and tries not to make his children and descendants receive the punishment.

Notice ⑤ Who punishes mankind?

- ① Who punishes the criminal, the judge or the criminal law.
- ⇒ According to the criminal law by the accusation of the prosecutor the judge decides to punish the criminal person.

...(defendant, accused)

② Who punishes the sinner, God or satan?

⇒ According to the Divine Principle (law of indemnity) by satan's accusation God allows satan to punish the sinner.

; After the fall, fallen mankind exists in the midway position between God and satan.

; If this person commits sin, he belongs to satan's side.

If this person does not commit sin, he belongs to God's side.

© 4 kinds of sin which are caused by evil desire through the 4 fallen natures.

⇒ 4 kinds of sin in Adam's family

a) Sin of falsehood, disbelief and rebellion.

⇒ God's Word "not to eat" is truth.

Satan's word "to eat" is false.

① For Adam and Eve to accept satan's word is the sin of falsehood.

For Adam and Eve not to accept God's Word is the sin of disbelief.

For Adam and Eve to become the slaves of satan and rebel against God is the sin of rebellion.

② Self-centered thought, desire and action are satan's view of life, evil theory, evil desire, and evil action.

⇒ Wrong religious doctrine, communist theory and all kinds of thoughts and theories against the Divine Principle are the sins of falsehood, disbelief, and rebellion.

③ In order to be liberated from these sins, we need to lead a life of oneness with God and True Parents through learning, believing, and practicing perfectly the Divine Principle, which is God's perfect word.

b) The sin of adultery (fornication, lewdness, lechery, lasciviousness).

⇒ It is the sin of adultery that the archangel, Eve and Adam committed.

① All marriages and any kind of love relationships between men and women other than the Blessing of the Unification Church are the sins of adultery.

⇒ Among Unification Church members, brothers should become priests or monks, and sisters should become nuns until receiving the Blessing.

; Among those who receive the Blessing, those who have affections toward men or women other than their spouses commit the sin of adultery.

② The satan of adultery comes from my own ancestors.

⇒ Devils of adultery manipulate people into marriages and divorces and cause them to lead dissolute and adulterous lives. Through this, the devils of adultery destroy families and human societies.

; The satan of adultery controls people and promotes the sin of adultery through pornographic movies and magazines.

③ Example from the Bible (John 8:3-11)

The prostitute who was captured at the scene of adultery and brought to Jesus confessed her own sin, repented with tears and paid indemnity (received punishment). Through this indemnity condition, she received forgiveness from Jesus.

c) The sin of murder (homicide, suicide)

⇒ Homicide began when Cain killed Abel. Through this, mankind created the history of murder and wars.

① The process of murder

Envy (knowledge, affection, position, property) ⇒ jealousy ⇒ arrogance ⇒ hatred ⇒ violence ⇒ invasion ⇒ murder (homicide, suicide)

② 3 kinds of drugs (narcotics) that lead to the sin of murder.

⇒ Gas drug is cigarettes (nicotine drug)

Liquid drug is liquor, wine or beer (alcohol drug)

Solid drug is opium, heroin, cocaine (poison)

⇒ By using these 3 drugs, I could kill myself, my own family, and other people, committing the sin of murder. In order to get money to buy these drugs, I could commit the sin of adultery, murder, and robbery.

③ Congressmen who drink liquor become less than...

...a dog, which does not drink it and serves its master absolutely.

d) The sin of robbery

① The archangel made Adam and Eve fall and became satan. By dominating fallen mankind, satan robbed all things automatically. This robbery of all things was the beginning of the sin of robbery.

② Kinds of sin of robbery according to the method:

1) Robbery (in the home, on the street, in the bank, on the train, in the store)

2) Swindler, cheat (individual and company)

3) Embezzler, usury (treasurer, accountant)

4) Thief, pickpocket (in the school, on the street, in the airport, in the home)

5) Bribery (illicit gains, irregularities, corruption)

⇒ Gambling (casino, lottery, card games, chess, go game, horse racing, bingo, stock market, money interest game, real estate game, capitol increasing game)

⇒ Those who don't offer tithes to God are committing the sin of robbery.

③ In order for someone to be liberated from the sin...

...of robbery, you should repay 4 times the amount of money which you robbed, like Zacchaeus (Luke 19:2-8)

④ How can God's Word be realized through Adam, Eve and the archangel?

① Adam and Eve received God's Word not to eat vertically.

⇒ Eve should have realized God's Word not to eat horizontally through the archangel and Adam should have realized God's word not to eat horizontally through fallen Eve.

② By men overcoming women's adulterous temptation and women overcoming men's adulterous temptation completely and victoriously, separation from satan is accomplished and the foundation of faith is established.

⇒ 1) Do not eat (Genesis 3:1-3)

2) Do not touch (Genesis 3:3)


3) Do not look (Genesis 3:6)

4) Do not think (Matthew 5:28)

5) Do not think even in dreams (1 Corinthians 6:15-20)

④ The examples of those who succeeded and failed in overcoming adulterous seductions “to eat” throughout the history of restoration.

① Four generations of Abraham’s family (Isaac, Jacob, Joseph)



② Moses' Course

- 1) Moses, as a prince, overcame the adulterous seductions of many women at the King's palace in Egypt for 40 years.
- 2) 80 year-old Moses overcame adulterous seduction twice through the two 40-day fasts. (Exodus 19:15) – all people, no sex for 3 days.
- 3) “Do not commit the sin of adultery.” (10 Commandments – Exodus 20:1-17)

⇒ Comparison between the 4 kinds of sins and the 10 Commandments.

Sin of falsehood, disbelief, and rebellion - 9, 1-4, 5

Sin of adultery - 7

Sin of murder - 6

Sin of robbery - 8, 10

③ Jesus' Course

1) Jesus overcame adulterous seduction through the age of 30 years old, like Joseph the 11th son of Jacob.

2) Jesus overcame adulterous seduction through the 40-day fast at the age of 30.

3) Overcame adulterous seduction (Lord's Prayer, Matthew 6:9-13)

⇒ Comparison between the 4 kinds of sin and the Lord's Prayer:

Sin of falsehood, disbelief, and rebellion - Matthew 6:9-10)

Sin of adultery - Matthew 6:13

Sin of murder - Matthew 6:12

Sin of robbery - Matthew 6:11


④ Noah's family – failure

1) Noah's second son Ham should have inherited Noah's victorious foundation of faith after the 40-day flood judgement centering on Noah's Ark.

- 2) Ham could not inherit and establish his own foundation of faith because he couldn't overcome adulterous seduction.
⇒ This chance was inherited by Abraham.
- ⑤ Adam's family – failure
 - 1) Abel was born as the second son of Eve who committed the sin of adultery.
 - 2) Abel, who offered the sacrifice successfully, should have overcome adulterous seduction. However, he lost his chance to overcome adulterous seduction because he was killed by Cain.
⇒ This chance was inherited by Ham.
- ⑥ Two kinds of conditions that the central figure must make in order to establish the foundation of faith.
 - 1) The central figure should overcome adulterous seduction absolutely.
 - 2) After overcoming adulterous seduction, the central figure should offer the sacrifice according to God's Will.





...making the following 4 conditions:


- 1) Receiving punishment from the enemy elder brother without having committed any kind of sin.

- 2) Because the elder brother (Esau) has established the foundation of faith, he willingly decides in his mind to obey, follow, and serve the younger brother (Jacob).
- 3) Therefore, the younger brother (Jacob) can...

...have the ability to make the elder brother (Esau) obey, follow, and serve him.

- ④ Finally, the younger brother (Jacob) restored the elder brother's birthright through subjugating satan.

- 4) Through natural science every nation and communist nations can be united by Divine Principle.


e) Conclusion

- ⑦ All things and the biological person can grow to reach perfection automatically because of these 3 functions (force of the Principle) in the seed.

c) Autonomy of the Principle and Dominion of the Principle

① What is the meaning of autonomy of the Principle?

⇒ Due to the seed energy, the plant seed sprouts, grows and bears fruit. All of these phenomena of the growth process are caused by one function of seed energy.

⇒ This one function, which is to realize the phenomena of the growth process, is called the Autonomy of the Principle.

② What is the meaning of the Dominion of the Principle?

⇒ When due to the seed energy the plant seed sprouts, grows and bears fruit, how is its kind (species) and form determined?

⇒ The kinds (species) and forms of all plants are determined by the design which is in the seed.

⇒ This other function of seed energy, which is to realize the form according to the design by combining the design and the Autonomy of the Principle, is called the Dominion of the Principle.





 - ⇒ According to the design, autonomy and dominion of the Principle, all things can grow to reach perfection automatically (God's design and form in the seed) by passing through the sphere of dominion over the result of the Principle in the growing period.
- ② The biological person and the sphere of dominion over the result of the Principle in the growing period.
 - ⇒ According to the design, autonomy and dominion of the Principle, the biological person can grow to reach perfection automatically (God's design and form in the seed) by passing through the sphere of dominion over the result of the Principle in the growing period.
- ③ The personality person and the period of immaturity in the growing period.
 - 1) The personality person can grow to reach perfection:
 - ⇒ through separating from satan by destroying my evil desire and rejecting satan's word to eat,
 - ; and by learning, believing, and practicing God's...

...Word not to eat.

- 2) It is God's responsibility to give His Word to mankind and it is man's responsibility to learn, believe and practice God's Word not to eat.
- 3) When mankind grows to reach perfection, he can gain 2 qualifications, one is to become the child of God and the other is to become the Lord of angels (to dominate all things and angels).
- 4) When the personality person gains these 2 qualifications, it becomes possible to pass beyond the period of immaturity in the growing period.

④ The personality person and the period of indirect dominion in the growing period.

⇒ Until the personality person reaches perfection by passing through the period of immaturity, which is in the growing period, God cannot dominate him directly but dominates him indirectly through God's Word.

Therefore, we call this period of immaturity, the period of God's indirect dominion.

⑤ The perfect person and God's direct dominion.

⇒ When man reaches perfection and gains the qualification to become the...

...child of God, God can directly dominate this perfect person.
; when man gains the qualification to become the Lord of all things and angels, God
allows man to dominate all things and angels directly.

- ④ The reason why God created mankind with human responsibility.
 - ① Because God created man and all things, He has the qualification to dominate man and all things (creativity \Leftrightarrow dominion)
 - ② In order for man to gain the qualification to become a child of God and to become the Lord of angels (to dominate all things and angels), man should create all things and angels.
 - \Rightarrow However, man has no ability to create all things and angels.
 - ③ Therefore, instead of mankind creating all things and angels, God gave mankind the qualification to become a child of God and to become the Lord of angels (to dominate all things and angels) through mankind creating his own human personality.
 - (creativity \Leftrightarrow dominion)
 - ④ Then, how is the human personality created?
 - 1) The creation of the human personality is realized through the personality person's growing to perfection.
 - 2) The personality person can grow to reach...

perfection:

- ⇒ through separating from satan by destroying my evil desire and rejecting satan's word to eat,
- ⇒ by learning, believing, and practicing God's Word not to eat.

3) It is God's responsibility to give His Word to mankind and it is man's responsibility to learn, believe and practice God's Word not to eat.

⑤ What is the core contents of God's word?

1) The core content of God's Word is God's commandment not to eat, which means not to commit sexual sin.

⇒ After receiving the Blessing, mankind can receive true love which is God's law of love.

2) Satan's law of love

⇒ Through satan's love the family, society and nation are destroyed.

; Satan's law of love allows marriage and divorce, changing partners, free sex, homosexuality, seeing pornographic movies and magazines through destroying the function of the conscience.

⑥ What are the results of reaching perfection?

When the personality person can grow to reach perfection, he gains two qualifications

1) He becomes a child of God

⇒ This means to establish the foundation of faith.

; Without separating from satan by rejecting the archangel's word to eat, no foundation of faith can be established.

2) He becomes the Lord of angels. (He can dominate all things and angels)

⇒ This means to establish the foundation of substance.

; Before the fall, without the younger brother restoring the elder brother's birthright by subjugating satan (the archangel), perfect mankind could automatically dominate all things and angels.

⑦ Conclusion:

1) Without mankind creating the human personality, God's purpose of creation cannot be realized.

2) God created mankind with human responsibility in order for God to give His grace to mankind, which is for mankind to be able to participate in God's great creation project by mankind creating his own human personality.

⇒ The baby resembles his parents and grandparents (4-7 generations) human structure and human actions, and inherits their 4 kinds of sins and receives their benefits.

1) Human structure

; External appearance

eyes, nose, mouth, ears, face, hair and skin color, hands, feet, height (tall or short), weight (fat or thin)

; Internal organs

lungs, heart, liver, kidneys, bladder, stomach

intestines, brain

2) Human actions

; tone of voice, laugh or cry, talking expression, appearance of character.

3) 4 kinds of sin

⇒ The baby resembles and inherits his parents' 4 kinds of sin.

(example - denying truth, sexual actions, murder and violence, robbery and gambling)

; The baby receives punishment for his ancestors' (who are in the spirit world) 4 kinds of sin. A baby less than 7 years old sometimes dies because of his ancestors' sin from the spirit world. Through this baby's indemnity, the ancestors in the spirit world receive benefit and are liberated from their sin.

(This phenomenon we call the law of returning resurrection)

4) I cannot change my structure design and form in the seed, but I can change my action design and form centering upon the Divine Principle.

⇒ To receive punishment is God's education or blessing to the good person. On the other hand, to receive punishment is God's curse to the evil person.
