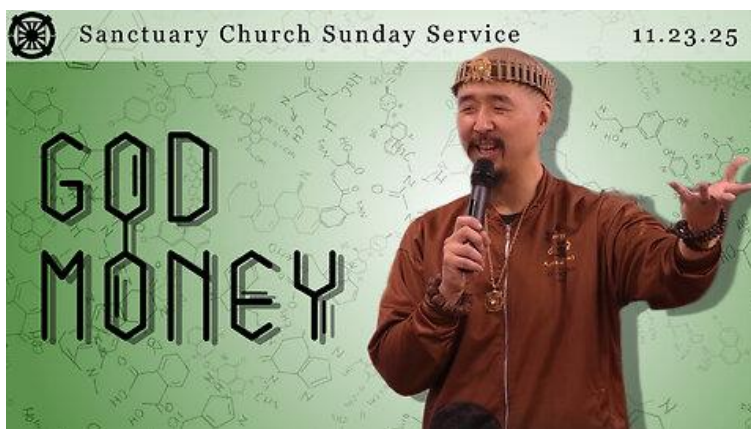

Please be seated, everybody. Hey! Look at all these extremists in this house! I got now almost as long a beard as some of you. I came back from China with a big *guangdong* beard. We got PA in the house; we got everybody in the house. Wow, all the crazy people came all over town. Hey, great to see everybody. Thank you all for your prayers. Don't say you miss me, okay? You can't say that. That is a sin, you understand? No, that's a sin. That's a sin, okay? You can't do that because I miss you all too much and you're gonna make me cry.

In China

Let's go to John chapter 4 today. John chapter 4. We actually covered this in the Chinese service. We're doing Chinese service, of course. We're doing Chinese service, but we can't put it up online because obviously we're trying to get the religious status there in Taiwan. You all understand the situation we are in; we're literally right there in front of China. There is obviously that kind of issue, but now it looks like maybe in March we'll get it. So, it is progressing, but we'll have to wait. We're not able to put the Chinese service online yet, but we are doing it every week, and folks are helping me with my Chinese, and all that. Our new brothers and sisters are receiving the word in Chinese, and of course are now growing, growing in the spirit, growing in the faith. We'll get into that.

I'm just coming off a Tennessee cold, it looks like. It's impossible to get a cold in that part of the world, you understand? It's 120 degrees with 100 % humidity. And you all know me, I'm bad with heat. Very bad. Heat is the worst thing for me. It's the most torturous thing. That's why I don't want to go to hell, I guess! (Laughter). But it's terrible. You know, we've got the big football legs. I get all sorts of terrible skin condition and rash and all that in the heat. But yeah, the heat is unbearable there. It's unbelievable. You see me in the linen Asian robes. They are

linen. They're like almost see-through; they're so thin. And still, I'm walking around in a layer of sweat every day. The heat is unbearable. I've never experienced that kind of heat.

You know, we used to go down with Father in the Amazon jungle. I was wondering, "why don't I remember it being this hot?" It's because in the summertime here, it's wintertime there. So, the Amazon was maybe 80, 90 degrees in the wintertime, just like it is now over there in Taiwan where it's officially winter. The first day of winter, we had 85 degrees. Palm trees get old really quick. I'll tell you that much, OK? Oh, Lord have mercy! 85 degrees. Golly!

So, I came back to Tennessee. The first time I felt 50 degrees. I took off all my dang layers. Maybe that's why I got a cold. I got a cold walking around with no shirt on for the last two days. It's crazy. But it's unbelievable, it's incredible. But it is what it is. Father is moving there. We'll show you the whole slide show and all the brothers and sisters that are gathered there and where the Holy Ghost is moving.

The Samaritan Lady at the Well

But let's get into the Gospel of John 4. And now we're here with the lady at the well in Sikar, a Samaritan woman. In the Chinese service we went from verse 6 to 24, but we're gonna jump to the red letters really quick.

So, Christ meets the woman of Samaria. This is Christ meets the woman of Samaria:

Verse 9: *"How is it thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me?"*

The woman is shocked. *"You are a Jew. How is it you ask of me which am a woman of Samaria? For the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans. Jesus said unto her, if thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, give me to drink with thou wouldest have asked of him and he would have given the living water."*

This is the first thing. At the time the Jews do not get near the Samaritans, and of course a Jewish man cannot speak to a Samaritan woman. That would be close to adultery, so they cannot do that. "They're a defiled race". That's an Old Testament issue: "We're the chosen people; everybody else are the Gentiles".

Candace Owens, the Black Mama of the West

And of course, we see this even now, in the West. The fact that the Rothschild Zionists run America is becoming more and more apparent. Everybody's starting to realize that. And the Charlie Kirk's assassination has so many ridiculous potholes; 30-06 will blow your freaking head off, you understand? Give me a freaking break! 30-06 will blow your neck off. Are you kidding? Ridiculous. Anyways, there are so many obvious lies.

Candace Owens, she's like the true mother figure. She is the black mama of the West. She's trying to save the West. (Applause) She's like the black mama of the West. She is exposing all

But it is not just about Charlie. He represents the West. So, is the West going to lie, or is the West going to tell the truth? Because if you're gonna lie about this... We all saw it. We all know you're lying. 30-06 is gonna blow your head right off, smack off. Any hunter knows that. Anybody who shoots knows that. Give me a break! That's 300-foot pounds of pressure in your

little chicken neck vertebra. Come on! Give me a break! We're not that stupid, daggone it. We have AI and the internet, even though those are both dangerous things. But it's terrible because the West is on trial. It's not just about Charlie; the West is on trial. And if the West will not tell the truth about this horrific public execution, potentially it's lying about everything, about whatever we've been told by the Western governments of the world.

If Trump fails his mission

This is a very dangerous time. Even though God and Father anointed Trump, if he fails his mission and does not take on and separate from the Rothschild Zionist power group, then of course America is in tremendous danger. Because he's become so unpopular now, that people are kind of saying, "Ah! I'm off the Trump train now. "His base is moving off. And in the next cycle, you know what that means, right? A fool like Mamdani is going to come in, some crazy commie like that. If Trump fails his mission, it's a tremendous, tremendous failure. And God will not be pleased with America and the West. So, this is a critical time; it's crisis time. And the days of even being able to speak about this are going to be limited if Trump fails his mission. Isn't that crazy? The land of freedom, home of the brave.

So, it is an existential crisis now, with the Charlie Kirk issue. This is not a small thing. Everybody saw it. Everybody saw it in the whole world. Everybody is watching. Everybody is watching. Everybody is seeing the incredible reporting Candace is doing every day risking her life. She's the only one out there risking her life, literally. Now she got a hit squad that's coming to assassinate her. I mean, that is a true friend, right? Give me a break! Father always told the black women, "You have to stand up and protect America." Candace Owens is like the fulfillment of the big black mama. She's not big, she's thin, but you understand what I'm saying.

The Rothschilds

But the point is, it's the empire of lies controlled by the political Satanists, the ones that Father was battling and fighting. He commanded Israel to CROWN JESUS. Which minister did that? Father commanded Israel and Netanyahu, "CROWN Jesus publicly." Remember that? Did they listen? Of course not. They're the chosen people, right, the perfect people! If you say anything about them, they're victims forever and ever. They can't do anything wrong. But they didn't

listen to Father; they didn't listen to the Lord, and they didn't crown Jesus. So, what did True Father do? He took a Muslim representative, Christian representative, Jewish representative, and crowned Jesus Himself in Jerusalem. You understand?

Who did that? Nobody. None of those Zionist Christian pastors that are being paid and funded by these non-profits from the Rothschild groups. On the left, they're funding Soros, who's a Zionist Rothschild, and then on the right, they're funding ALC, (Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez), right? So, it's the common Rothschild system. You fund the English, you fund the French, and tell everybody "Waterloo, he's WON!" That's the classic Rothschild move. "He won; he won! Napoleon has WON!" Everybody sells their stock, they buy them up cheap, and now they own England. And the crown of England had to bow and literally give their children to marriage with the Rothschilds.

That's their system. They fund both sides, make money; it doesn't matter who wins. They make money as a business model, which is why you see the endless wars. Trump is trying to bring peace. He's trying to be the president of peace. I mean, when have we seen this in the last fifty years of American history? At least he's trying to make peace; he's trying to make peace in all these different areas. And he's made eight wars stop. But as soon as he brings peace in the Middle East, then Israel starts bombing everybody else. They just started bombing Lebanon again.

It's absurd and the young men are waking up to this ridiculousness, because they're going to be commanded to go die. They can't afford a house and they have no future in America. And especially if they're white, they can't say anything. They've got to hate themselves and hate their ancestry. Right?

In the West

Because this is what's so crazy: in the West, you're supposed to hate your ancestry. You have no more ancestry. This is incredible. We've come back from China. I've been gone maybe six, seven months now. We started renting that place in June. So that's like what? Six months? But you know, we were there before then as well. The point is: I come back to America. I'm sitting in the airport. I'm like, "Dang! What the hell is this? You got the Arabs over there you got the blacks over there; you got the whites over here." It's becoming a stratified open prison. Of course, with all the political climate, everybody is trying to make resources or something like that.

There's no unifying culture now in America. There is none. At least when the white folks were 65%, 75%, you still had a culture. You still had the white Anglo -Saxon Protestant culture, the Dutch culture. You had a common denominator. Now, you're down to 40 % because you're not having babies. You're down to 40% and of course we have the mass migration. With all the wars that we did over there, we brought them in. And guess what? Those folks reproduce quick. So now the white Anglo -Saxon Protestant demographic is 40 % and dying.

And you can't keep a country together if you don't have a unifying culture. Think about it. If you have nothing in common with your neighbor, you're going to fight him at some point. If you can't agree that marrying a six-year-old baby is not good, I'm going to fight you at some point. You understand? Is that true? If we can't even agree on that. "Hey, maybe six years old is a little too early". Or like the Talmud says, three-year-old. Are you kidding me? Three-year-old? See, if we can't agree on just simple basics, you understand how the society falls apart. The whole point is if we had a Christian ethic, even a simple, basic Christian ethic, like "Love God, love your neighbor", that is still a very powerful unifying force.

But, more and more, people don't believe that. I see Islamic camp getting bigger, the Zionist Jews camp is getting bigger and stronger. But Christians are being split. Now they see the Orthodox or the Catholics or the dangerous extremist forms of Christianity that don't support the Zionist Scofield Bible etc. kind of start making sense. Why Russia is so hated while Putin is strengthening the Orthodox Church? And I'm not saying they're great or anything. Orthodox Church will kill us. I guarantee you that. You understand? They're known to be totalitarian when they get power, OK? It's not like they have a great history of liberty.

But the point is that since these cabals are fighting, they're now saying that obviously the very conservative, non-pro-Zionist Christian factions are evil; they are extremists, a danger. That makes the majority of Gen Z now an extremist and dangerous population, that is going to Orthodox and Catholicism, because they're leaving Protestantism.

Protestant Matriarchy

Protestantism has become way too relative. It's become the anus rainbow cult in the West. In South Korea right now, everybody's talking about, "Oh, the Christians grew so fast in South Korea." They did, but they were supposed to serve the Lord. Do you understand? They were supposed to unite with True Father. He is the patriarch of their churches. If the father was at home, they wouldn't be communist right now in South Korea. The biggest pusher of socialism and "gay rights" and all this stuff is what? It's the megachurches just like you got in the West. The West is further along down the path, but the anus rainbow cult, this is what they're leading the Korean church to. Because everybody knows that the Protestant church doesn't have a patriarchy.

Obviously, the women are gifted because they're compassionate and sensitive. So when they do religious work, I mean, we all know that women work hard. They many times outperform the men in religious work. It's just a reality. In any religion, you'll see it. But the point is that in Protestantism, they take over. The pastors are just changed out. So, it's become a matriarchy. The very important value in the world of the feminine versus the masculine is niceness, kindness. Kindness is very important. Is that true? Being kind to one another is very important. It's a cardinal value in the woman's realm. And we need that, we need that kindness, to a certain degree.

But you need to have the patriarch; you have to have the father there. You cannot just be kind to everything, right? Because then the wolves come in and they take over. And that's why the husband's there, to watch out. So at least in the Orthodox and Catholic churches, there's obviously a very clear patriarchy. All the priests, the cardinals, the pope, et. are all males. So, these young men who grew up in these feminized matriarch churches, they're like, "Man, we're sliding; every generation we're sliding more and more to be completely leftist. I can't be part of this. I need to go where there's some male leadership and I'm not demonized for being a man." So, the young people are now gravitating to Orthodox and Catholicism because at least there's a visible patriarch that the hardworking women can't take over because those positions are locked in. They have to be males, right?

The Western Protestant church, even though it spread in Korea as well, is very weak now. Obviously, they have factions within. There are the conservative parts of the Christian Church, and they're good folks. They battle with us on the front line in South Korea and Japan; they're allies with us. So, we're not poo -pooing everybody. But you look at it, it's becoming just like the West; that's the phenomena. It's like the big megachurches, which you all know are controlled by the government; they're all controlled by the funding. Those megachurches are just pushing socialism, communism, liberalism and feminism on the population, all these things that break down and destroy the family. That kind of situation is terrible for these people, terrible.

So, when Father opens up China, it's much better that China is not just taking in Western Protestantism and within one generation start pushing communism again, just as it is happening now in Korea. That's not the way. You need the father. It's better to follow True Father and bow to True Father. If China does that, then they will preserve all their culture because the Western churches do not let any form of ancestor veneration in the East or anywhere. They do not allow; it's forbidden. You have to cut off your tie with the ancestors because they see ancestor worship as idol worship. Which is one of the big reasons why for example they cannot spread in Japan because Japan has a real tie to the ancestral heritage. In the West we call it nepotism, but in Japan they have thirteen generations tea makers, thirteen generation farmers. You know, they see this as a good thing that is being passed down from father to son.

The West without Tribe or Lineage

In the West, that's bad, because y'all have been brainwashed to be against tribe and lineage. You've been so atomized, individualized. And how's that working out for you? Not well. You're all lonely, isolated, and you're mentally ill. Thirty-three percent of women in the West are clinically psychopathic. Did you know that? It's unbelievable. That's never happened in human history. Never! How is it that high? It's unbelievable. That's unfathomable. One in three is a psychopath in the West. Wow! How do women in the West become so crazy? You got more money than ever. You got more liberation. You can do all your crazy feminism and all that ridiculousness. You can be empowered women splitting your legs open. That's empowerment!

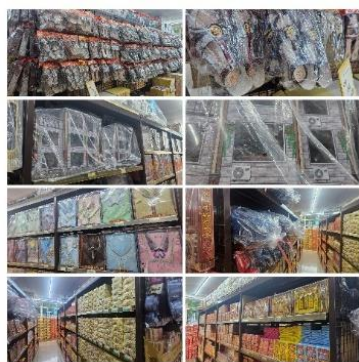
Okay, you can do all that, but you're more miserable and now you're psychotic. What is going on? This never happened before in the history of humankind. We never had thirty percent of women be psychopaths. Never. Now, some of you all men may think that was the case. It's not. It's not been that high. It's kind of like near one percent, not like thirty percent. Holy shmita! This is bad. Some husbands say, "Well, I think my wife may be". Silence!

But how is that working out for you? You turned away from the father. You just went towards the free sex and the free culture and doing what is pleasurable now, and what has happened? This culture is dead. You have no more culture; you're now being taken over by other tribes. You have no more tribal identity. I mean it's happening now; it's already happening. America is getting taken over.

Of course they're purposely doing it, right? They're purposely bringing in hard tribes, people that are hardcore about tribes, crazy, crazy hardcore about tribe like the Arabs or the Muslims. They're not playing around; they're here to conquer folks, while everybody in the West is trying to live the "American dream." How is your white picket fence working for you all now? You got the conquerors coming in. Maybe there's something more important than a white house and a white picket fence. But of course, I'm an extremist and an anti -Semite and a white supremacist if I say this. But I was quite shocked coming back to the West, sitting in the airport. I said, "Oh my gosh, what is it? We have no dang culture".

Ancestors' Veneration in China

Because I've been steeped in Chinese culture for the last, what, eight months, maybe? We were scouting already from February. So, what's that? Like nine months, right? We went to Kinmen Island. We were praying, "Down with the CCP!" So, I've been steeped in the unified culture. There is one culture there. There is one culture there and they are fanatic about ancestor veneration. Oh my God! I honestly have never seen it go this hard. I've never seen it. They go hard. Oh my gosh! Wow!



In China, every month they're burning paper money, paper Louis Vuitton bags, paper Mercedes Benzes. There's a religious mall. I like going and checking out the religious shops, so, I'm checking it out. It's called a religious mall. I walk in there; there is air conditioning. You can buy paper air conditioning for your ancestors, because it might get hot up there or down there. (Laughter) You can buy paper Mercedes Benzes. I'm not joking. Y'all are saying, "What are you talking about?" OK, when you come, I'll show you. I'll show you. There are stacks of paper money. There are apartment buildings; there are castles. There are fake Louis Vuitton bags and slippers and pajamas for your grandpa. I'm not joking. We literally filmed this because I knew nobody would believe me.

But yeah, they got money everywhere. And every month on the third week or something like that, they're burning all the stuff in front of the shop.



Everybody comes out in front of the shop and they're burning it. They're burning, throwing the money. It's like paper money. The inflation in the spirit world is ridiculous because they print money like insanity. You understand what I'm saying? I mean, you thought the US was bad. Holy shmita! Man, I just sent the ancestors a billion last week. You know, they already ran out.

Golly! What are you buying up there? Grandpa, come on! Lord, have mercy! That's a pretty low spirit world. I'm definitely not bragging about that. That's a pretty low spirit world obviously. That's pretty sad.

But the point is that it's very serious. In late August early September is the hungry ghost month and that's where a monk asked the Buddha, "My mom got reborn as a hungry ghost; she can't eat anything. So, could you please open up the gates of hell so she could come out for a month?" That's why for a month they're doing this feast, the big feast and the big table. I mean, right on the street, people come out of the shop. On big tables, they're burning huge things and feast. It's the Hungry Ghost Month. I never experienced that, actually. I never saw that particular festival. It was pretty crazy to experience that.

That's the level. So of course, it's not something to brag about or anything. But it's very interesting, because we meet also young people in that part of the world, and the rebellious ones. Victor Moon is a B -boy, and he's attracting all these B -boys too, witnessing them in the process. And it's very interesting, because these B -boys, you would imagine, they're the worst rebellious type of kids. That they don't listen to their parents, they don't believe in anything. They're just hedonists; they're just atheists. In the West, that's probably predominant; ninety-five percent of the rebellious kids are going to be atheists, right?

It's crazy. In China, the kids are not atheists. Western atheism and materialism are not the dominant belief system there for the young kids. Isn't that crazy? They're pagans. They still believe in a spirit world. So, they do the Hungry Ghost Festival. They do the burning the money. I don't know if they believe it. They probably think it's a little bit of mythology or something like that.

We got these rebellious kids, tattooed from head to toe, talking to us about, "Yeah, this demon attacked me". What? How old are you, boy? I would never hear that in the West. You know what I mean? Oh my gosh! Usually, the kids in the West, they're brainwashed to be materialists, evolutionists, materialists, atheists. That is, there's nothing more beyond the materials of the universe. This is a specific type of atheism that's tied in with evolutionary doctrine and tied in with materialism and things like that.

But in China, I was shocked. It's like, these kids are not actually materialists. These kids, they actually believe in some type of spirit realm. They don't believe in extinguishing after death,

like you die and that's it, as a lot of the West believes. They believe that when you die, you have a spirit. Your ancestors exist. Don't pick up the red note. Anybody knows about the red note. If you pick up the red note, you're going to get married to a ghost. Don't pick up the red envelope on the floor, especially during Hungry Ghost Month, because that's where they're getting hitched. They're tricking you. If you pick it up, now you're married to a ghost. Now they're going to be haunting you, haunting you, chasing you around.

Apologetics for Atheists

But the Western issue is a big issue because the predominant worldview of the West is to become materialist, atheist, especially in a young people community. That's why our apologetics system and our whole program is based on witnessing an atheist person. We're hitting you with the fine-tuning argument, we're hitting you with the contingency arguments, we're hitting you with the logic, we're hitting you with the time arguments, we're hitting you with the different arguments that are against your atheism. Which is built into you by the Prussian school of education system that is now the federal system in America, implemented and started by Horace Mann, who brought it from Hitler. You wonder why, you send your kids to school and they come out communists. That's because it's a program, it's a whole system, it's an indoctrination system.

If you don't homeschool your children, you lose 36,000 hours with them. 36,000 hours if you don't homeschool your children! They say, "Man, why does he always talk about homeschooling? Hey, my kid, can get" Huh, 36,000 hours! You are giving that to somebody else who is a worker of the state, which is part of an indoctrination system to make your child into a materialist and an atheist.

Because they're easy to control with the "trust the science" culture. Remember that during COVID? The atheists and "trust the science", right? OK. Easy to control, part of the cult. Very, very easy. When the "experts" came out, that's what they all said. You all remember that one, right? That's still part of our memory, is that right? We didn't forget about that one. That's a very important part of our memory then, very important.

God is a Spirit

In the West, you have this horrific, horrific problem. But in China culture, what we've noticed is that they're not all atheists. A big portion of the young people are pagans. This is the same kind of grounds as when Christianity entered into Korea. Korean young people were not atheists, materialists. They were shamans. They were mountain spirit worshipers. Do you understand? They were pagans. Pagans at least believe in some type of spirit world. You understand, folks?

In the Bible, John chapter 4 deals with this very issue with the Samaritan woman.

21 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor

yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.

We will worship God as spirit. We will worship Him in spirit and truth. That's the whole scripture right here. In pagan lands, they believe in some type of spirit. They shouldn't be boasting about being a pagan, but at least they're open to a spirit realm. God is a what? Spirit.

Let's jump to 23.

23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth. 24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

He didn't say, "for God is material". He said, "God is a spirit". A spirit. So, if you believe in the spirit realm, that is actually not bad.

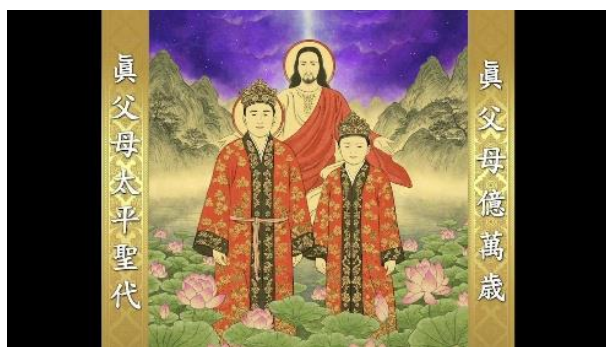
Early Christians in Pagan Lands

It really is like when Paul went to the pagan lands, went towards Rome, et cetera. Why? Because in Jerusalem, they started killing the Christians, right? They started going against the Christians. The Jews were not being receptive; they were not being nice to Jesus. They killed Him, right? So, the Christian community, obviously, started evangelizing, proselytizing the

whole other parts of the Mediterranean, all the way to the East, to Turkey, and to Syria, and Paul in Rome, and all that. That's why the Book of Romans was written.

But what are those? Those are like pagan lands. I mean, Paul even talks about it. I think it was in Romans chapter 3. Anyways, Paul talks about the different churches of Athens, and about Athena. Remember this? And the different idol makers all around who are trying to kill Paul because they're saying there's a new god in town, etc. So, it's like going into the pagan lands, but the pagan lands at least they believe in some type of spirit world. And of course, since they believe in all these gods, they actually...

A 10,000-Year-Old Culture



In the Taiwan sanctuary, we have the big Jesus, big True Parents, beautiful photo with the long robes set up with these beautiful, mystical mountains in a traditional Shangri-la style and lotus flowers coming up from the water. And people just come in, like the air-condition man or some plumber etc., they come in and bow. We got the bowing seats there, too. They see that; they come in, and say, "Oh! Whoa!" and

do a full bow. Right away. They come in. They're like, "That must be a god, so we bow." Then they just start burning incense and stuff like that. Now, obviously that's where they begin. That's not where they stay. We want them to learn about the Bible and the history of Providence, et cetera. But you can see immediately, the landscape is so different.

In the West, you can't. Bowing is seen as a cult practice. I mean, it's seen as very dangerous in the West. I remember when we were doing the Freedom Festival and all the Japanese and Korean brothers and sisters were coming from Korea and Japan, and they were like, "Oh, it's the 2nd King and Queen." They're like bowing at us. So, we were constantly saying, "OK, OK, stop. Please stop". But you can't; it's the culture. You can't stop a 10,000-year culture. Everybody has tried. They tried. I mean, the British have tried. The French have tried. You can't pull out the root of a 10,000-year culture. You can't. You're not going to pull it out. Your arms will fall out trying to pull that root out.

But in Asia, it's very normal. The first-time guests come in, and they see, "Oh, he's the priest. He's the abbot here. OK, bow." First day. These people, we don't know. Because even in the normal families, every year in Asia, you do a full bow to your parents. You do a full bow to grandpa and grandma. Unthinkable in the West! Unthinkable! It's actually designated as a type of satanic thing in the West.

China, Korea & Japan, Same Cultural Realm

It's so much culture clash, and obviously there's no way you can get those things out of our religion, because we are from Korea. Father's deeply steeped in Asia and Korea. North Korean culture is tied very closely with China. Koreans hate it when I say this. But I say, "Look, I speak both Korean and Chinese. Do you speak Chinese?" They say, "NO!" I say, "Chinese and Korean are the same language." They get angry, "Grrr! You're making me angry". The same dang language, do you understand? It's like 80 % the same. Every phrase, every colloquialism, every cultural reference, every sentence, it's exactly the same.

And *Hangul* was produced in the 1600s. So, Chinese pre -1600s is what Korea has in it. And for example, if you look at Father's written texts, half of it is Chinese. So, the normal young Korean folks, they cannot read Father's writings, because there are so many Chinese characters.

Now, Japanese don't like that either. You also are Chinese. Japanese is also Chinese. Literally the same way. Like if I don't know a word in Chinese and I know it in Korean, I will guess the pronunciation and maybe six, seven times out of 10, I'll get it right. Just by guessing. I know it in Korean. I'm just going to guess it in Chinese with a little bit of a wacky accent. You know what I mean? And I'll get it.

Obviously in our church, we don't have the big racism that the Korean church in general has towards other Asian nations because Father told us we are unifying the whole world under Christ. So, we don't have that part of it. But I always tell the Koreans, "Don't hate the Chinese or the Japanese; they are our brothers and sisters. Don't hate them. How are you going to get them to say be saved if you hate them? Daggone it! You got the same dang last name". You know how big the dang Lee tribe is? Y'all heard about Bruce Lee, huh? Give me a freaking break! Lord, have mercy! They're talking about "my Lee clan is..." That's the same dang clan of Bruce Lee from Hong Kong. Give me a break! They like to do that; they like to claim.

Respect Your Ancestors

No, no, it's very important that we love the Chinese people because they obviously are so oppressed. But they're also prepared people. Just like Korea, the Chinese people are prepared too. They have the same cultural realm. If they can accept True Father, and Cheon Il Guk spreads in China, obviously it will outperform the West because it has the Cheon Il Guk Constitution which is the Rod of Iron Kingdom, and it has even more freedoms than the West.

You don't have to destroy your ancestry. You don't have to sever your ties with your ancestors, as the Western Protestant Church makes you do. You can't worship them, but you can respect them. You can still do the table of offering for them. You don't worship them, but you thank God that they've been liberated, and work on God's side. So that's huge. Are you kidding me? So better to accept the returning Lord, because then your 10,000 years of history will be preserved. You don't have to separate from your historical clan. Just get them all saved. Get

them liberated. And you don't have to pay \$21,000 a generation. The price tag is zero, OK? We just want you all to be saved. That's all. Happy, happy.

In the West Everything is Disconnected

People in the West do not understand how heavy this connection to the respect of the ancestors, the respect of their tribe is. The West has lost that. So, it's become itemized, isolated, fragmented, disassociated, like floating in gook with other things coming into it. Big trouble, big trouble.

We see in John chapter 4 that Christ did not come for just the chosen people. He came for the gentiles too; He came for the Samaritan woman, who was from an unpure, defiled, satanic line. Everything is so disconnected; it's a problem. Because if the culture becomes so atomized, so isolated, everybody is an island, and nobody can connect, that's going to fragment. That's why the Western families are fragmenting. The government rules everything, is involved in everything. It's a big disaster.

If Trump doesn't do his mission and fails his mission. It's a tremendous danger still. But God is moving. And many times, God can use even evil kings. In the Bible, we see that with Babylon; we see it with the Babylon captivity. We see it with all sorts of history through the Old Testament as well. God will use the evil for His good.

Chinese, on Training & Money

For example, in Taiwan, in China, we were launching the prayers out. We were doing a seven-times-a-day prayer, 40-day training with the Hoonsa-nims. Chinese people really appreciate that one. They actually really appreciated it. The folks just walking through, "Man, these guys do a lot of prayer, a lot of training."

You know, we've got the young people training two hours a day in the morning. They're meant to do the true love spinal cord training two hours a day. That's going to transform your life. If you do the true love spinal cord training two hours a day, you WILL be totally different. You will be different with that kind of training. Let's put it that way: you'll get in a lot less fights with your wife and your husband, a lot less. But the Chinese folks really appreciate that. They see that and say, "Man, you guys are training hard". They see us in the morning, we're training the martial art training and doing that stuff too, "Man, you guys are training hard." They really appreciate it; they really respect that.

And right after the 40-day, seven times a day prayer training, literally the next morning, we got up and Han Hakja, The Harlot of Babylon was in prison. She was arrested. Literally the next day after the 40-day! So, her judgment has now come. The betrayal of Father, the idol worship, the worship of herself, the rejection of Christ, etc., all this stuff that we've been talking about for thirteen years now is visible, very visible to even the people who want to doubt it. But they

can't. She's now locked up. The judgment has begun on those traitorous organizations. Because in the end, it's not the organization, right? That is not the *tianqian*. Everybody, say, " *tianqian*." (*Tianqian*.) OK, there you go. That's heaven's money. The Bible says, store your what? "Treasures up in heaven?" In Chinese, we call it heaven's money.

Chinese people are fanatical about money, money, money, money, money, money, money, blessing, money, blessing. They got the year of the chicken. There's a gold chicken sitting on a mound of money. Year of the pig. The pig is sitting on money. Year of the horse. The horse is galloping on money. Chinese are just fanatic about money, money, money. We'll get into why.

I think we're going to go pretty long today. We better open up the windows. I don't think we're going to go short. New guests, be warned. I think we go long today. New guest, be warned, we're not going 30 minutes today. We go maybe like five or six hours today. This is a seminar; it's seminar day today. Okay, so y'all be prepared for that. You're not going to meet before lunch. We're not having lunch. Do we have a blessing today? (Yes) Oh, we do. That's wonderful! Praise God. What better blessing on a Blessing Day than to get people on a training.

The Land of the Dragon



But the point is, the Chinese world is prepared that way. We didn't even know that. For example, China is the land of the dragon, right? So, it's a dragon. And in China, the dragon is like a god. It represents the *Huangdi*, who is the yellow emperor. The yellow emperor, he's the only one that can wear the gold and the yellow robe with the blue dragon on it, with the five fingers. The Korean king, for example, he could only wear a red robe. He could not wear a yellow robe, otherwise he would be challenging the Chinese

emperor and he would get wiped out.

Korea was a vassal state to China, Mongol, Manchu for 5,000 years. Being raped, pillaged, and plundered approximately every five years, on average 1,000 times over a 5,000-year history. Korea was a slave state to China. So, I get it. I definitely get it. That's why they don't like the Chinese. I get it. Totally understandable. I totally, totally understand.

But the point is, it's a land of the dragon. So, in the West, it's usually, "Oh, China's the land of the dragon. That serpent is Satan. They worship Satan". But the dragon is not a real serpent, obviously. It is a composition of all the different animals. So, it's got the reindeer horns. It's got the cow nose. It's got the lion's teeth. It's got the whiskers of the carp. It's got the scales of the fish. It's got the body of the snake. It's got the feet of the eagle. Blah, blah, blah, blah, blah. OK? So, it's not a Western dragon. You know what I'm saying? It's like a compilation of all the different animals.

Chungmonim's Baby Womb Vision for True Father

The point is, when Father was born, since they were not Christian yet, Chungmonim, *충모님*, his mother who is like Maria, had a dream. This is a *Mengshi*, meaning like a baby dream. In Asia, that's a big thing. In the West, you don't have that. It's a vision or a dream about a child that's supposed to be born, and that's called a *Mengshi*. That's very common in the East; Japanese, Korean people, y'all know what that is. But in the West, you don't have that. "What is your *Mengshi* about your baby?? "What?" You don't have it. *Taemong* or *Mengshi* is about the womb dream. It is very common in East Asia to have a dream or some kind of vision about the baby.

When Father was in the womb, then Chungmonim had a vision. That's the one that we're commissioning now with the two white dragons that came out when Father was born. That's why, for example, in Father's bloodline, Father's brothers and sisters, all the males are named Yong. They have Yong in their name, which means dragon. So, the two white dragons come out in the dream. And for the people who are not Christian yet- they're Confucius, they're in Buddhism land- in that land, that's the most auspicious heavenly beast that can ever appear. You understand?

Just like the Egyptian kings. They're having visions that they can understand through the Egyptian lens, that God has given them for Joseph to interpret. So, the white dragon has come out in Father's *Mengshi* dream. It's a sign tremendously auspicious that some world-changing, cosmic-shaking person is coming. You understand? That's what it means. Especially when the five-fingered dragons come out. The Koreans are the slaves to the Chinese, who is the emperor, right? And these white dragons are bowing, and they're protecting this baby. It means that the emperor is gonna bow to this baby. You understand what I'm saying? That is a real historical Chungmonim dream.

Our Intangible Cultural Treasure

And that's what we are now making with the beautiful Chen Laoshi (Teacher Chen) whom we witnessed in. He's our first totally new blessed couple after three-day ceremony and everything, and he's a master, master, master, master craftsman, artist. Unbelievable! Our tradition has never, never had this level of world-class art. In about a month, we will do the opening with prayers and ceremonies. Unbelievable. Unbelievable. This is *Inggamunajae* *인가무나제* meaning intangible cultural treasure. You know what that is?

Like, if there's some artist in Asia that makes pots or something, he's designated as an intangible cultural asset and his pieces are made by the "intangible cultural asset artist". You understand what I'm saying? In the West, I don't think you have this, but in the East, you do. The living artist, or whatever, is designated as a living national treasure. Yeah, that's another way to say it; intangible cultural asset or living national treasure. I don't know how you translate it.

Anyways, it means that this guy is holding the heritage of this particular tradition of woodworking, artistry, etc., with teas, farming, whatever it is. And this man, this is the treasure; this is the national treasure of our generation. You understand what I'm saying? I could never get this kind of level in Korea. Never. In Japan, never. What Chen Laoshi has produced is unbelievable. For the first time in our history, we have this type of museum-level art about Father's life story now coming to the forefront. (Applause) Unbelievable! It's only the beginning. And it's so cheap. My gosh, in China, it's so cheap. I can't believe it.

Three Dragon Stories

But it's amazing because, you know, the next generations have never encountered Father. So, the iconographic tradition is a way for the next generations to connect with the mythical stories that surround Father. The Chungmonim birth story is one of them with the white dragons. We were doing this research because I'm working on these projects. Then I did Father's life course story in the paintings with the Queen. I did a 12 -piece painting set and then also I did some big ones, like huge ones with the tiger in a cave and then the white dragon ones. Those are in the sanctuary but the point is this artistic tradition is now level up, game up.

So, we had **the white dragon story**.

And then also, we didn't know that, but Shigeru's father-in-law, who's right there, Professor Kwon, was doing some research on the dragon stories. And in Father's words, he found more. Father talks about it in His word. That when he was eight years old, Chungmonim – that's his mom- His mother came to Him and said, "Basically, you're going to have a big, heavy responsibility; you're going to have a big mission. "You know, something like that (difficult to translate due to the lack on nuances in the English language). Father was eight years old. He recounts this in the work, that when He was eight years old, His mom sat Him down and said, "You have a big responsibility. When you were in the womb, I had another vision." In that part of North Korea, there was a typhoon, a big kind of storm that they got hit with, and she was going towards her relatives. She had to pass this mountain. What was the name of the mountain? Mount Chae Seok in North Korea. I don't know how big it is, I don't know how it looks like. But while Chungmonim was passing, she had a vision. She saw **two golden dragons** come out from the earth, and they started riding this mountain in the typhoon. And then those golden dragons bowed to her womb.

It was not like the white dragon. These were golden dragons. We never heard about this. The Korean people never told us about that one. Y'all probably never heard about that one. Yeah, this is another one. We understand. Dragon means China, and China is the slave master, so we hate China, we hate the dragons, even though they appear to Father's story and they're bowing to Father. That's kind of a BIG thing. You missed out a BIG detail there. That's an important thing. That's like the slave master is bowing down, you understand? The emperor is bowing down. That's kind of an important point that I would like to have known, okay?

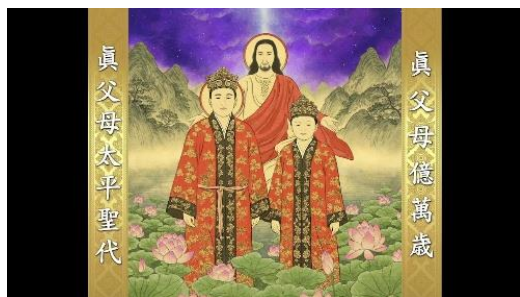
And then there's another one. Father recounts another story. When Father was in the womb, His granddaddy had a vision from the ocean; **two dragons came out from the ocean, bowing** to the baby. Have you ever heard of this? Neither did I. But we found it. We have all the scripture references, etc. It was quite exciting to see that. I said, "Wow! Baby, this is unbelievable," because this is now like 105 years after that, right?

But those prophecies are for now. They're for NOW. They're for this moment right now when Father's Kingship is in China. This is what it was for. Unbelievable. (Applause) When I meet these people in China, the first thing, I say is, "Did you know that when True Father was born, the white dragons came, and they bowed? Then the golden dragons came, and they bowed. And the sea dragons came up, and they bowed". And they don't know what the hell I'm talking about, but they're like, "Oh, oh, wow". They don't know who is True Father. This first person I met said, "Hey, did you know that the dragons came and bowed to True Father?" They were like, "dang!"

They don't believe in physical dragons like that, obviously, right? Chinese people are not stupid. East Asians and Ashkenazi Jews have the highest IQ in the world, so, when they have freedom, they will perform well. They will perform very well. They will outperform most nations if they have freedom and not this crazy tyranny. But the point is, they're not stupid people. Don't think that just because they're pagans, they're stupid. They all have 100 IQ. These people are not stupid. But they're open to the spirit world, you understand? There's a difference, right? They're open to the spirit world. So, when they hear a story like that, "Oh, what is that? What is that? What is that with the dragon? Who is this True Father? "

The Maitreya Buddha

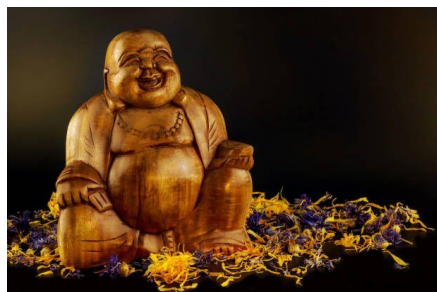
And many times, they will have a 弥勒佛 (*Mílè Fó*). In Chinese, the *Mílè Fó* is the Maitreya. Now, y'all have heard of Maitreya in the Divine Principle, right? It's one of the tangential religions God is building up to meet the Messiah. It's the same person.



When you walk into the sanctuary, you see that photo. The top -not shown here- says, "The Returning Lord, Maitreya Buddha, the Righteous Man of Confucianism, the Mahdi and the King of Peace." That's right up on top. Everybody who comes in sees that right up on top.

So, when they hear about the dragon story, I tell them about the Returning Jesus. They don't know anything. They're not from a Christian culture. It's only 4 % Christian, 96 % Pagan. They have no biblical understanding. So obviously, that has to change; they have to understand the providential history.

But they know Maitreya. You all are probably used to seeing the Japanese or Korean Maitreya, which is skinny, and sitting in the Tushita heavens; he's sitting like that, looking down. He's like thinking about coming down soon. That's how usually Korean and Japanese Buddhism depicts the Maitreya.



China is different. China depicts the Maitreya, as the big, fat Buddha? That's Bodhisattva. He is based off an 8th century monk who was this big fat monk who would bring blessings and food for the poor. But in Chinese Buddhism, that has become the Maitreya. When I was on the ground, they kept on saying it's the Maitreya.

I said, "No, no, in Korea, this is the Maitreya. In Japan, this is the Maitreya. This is usually the iconography of Maitreya".

-"No, no, no, no, no, this is the one". So, they use the fat Buddha. You know in America, when you walk into every Chinese restaurant that probably has a lot of CCP spies, they got a big fat Buddha. They're already waiting for the Lord. They already actually have an altar for the Lord. It's already there. Did you know that?

So, for example, if they have that Maitreya Buddha, then I will immediately start talking about that: "OH! You have the Maitreya Buddha right here. You know the Maitreya Buddha, he's the returning Lord. He's the Mahdi. That's True Father. When He was born, the white dragons came, the gold dragons came; the sea dragons came. And they all BOWED before the Lord". And we get into it. The Tien. What is the *Tianqian*? It means the god-money.



Okay, so the one on the bottom left, that's **the Fat Buddha**. That's the Maitreya in China. That's different. Korea Buddhism does not depict him like that. He's skinny. He's too skinny in Korea. That boy needs some weight lifting, okay? Because he's definitely like Father. Father was a wrestler, dang on it. A champion wrestler. Yeah, the one at the bottom, that's the Maitreya in China. So, I had to make sure; I had to confirm many times with multiple artists, "Are you sure this is how you do the Maitreya?" They're sure!

The Shaolin Temple

(Top left) And that's **Damo Dashi**, he's the founder of the Shaolin Temple. You know, all martial arts in the modern day, all Japanese, Jujitsu, it stems from the Shaolin Temple from the 5th century on. I also trained at the Shaolin Temple. Father sent me to Shaolin, and I trained at Shaolin Temple with the monks. Dechao Sinim was my Shifu" (师父).

I didn't spend six years there. I don't know how that mythology formed, okay? The Chinese, they keep on telling everybody, "The Second King spent six years at the Shaolin Temple. That's why he speaks such good Chinese". I said, "Bro, I never said that. How did you get to six years, man? It was three weeks." I don't know how it gets to six years. Golly! Y'all gotta calm down. Jeez. Six years. But I did train there. My son-in-law found the pictures of me training at Shaolin. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ap61Zlx-JLI>

So, you have the Shaolin founder, Damo Dashi. This is also very good. Unlike traditional martial arts of other nations in East Asia, Japan is different because they have the katanas and all that. But Korean traditional martial art is more like empty hands combat stuff, or kicking based. It's not really a heavy weapons thing. The Shaolin empty hand stuff is a joke. It's ridiculous even though the monks do practice *Sanda*, which is kickboxing. It's an actual type of kickboxing, with punch in the face and everything. So, they actually do a type of kickboxing with throws. That's called Chinese *Sanda*, Chinese kickboxing. They have matches and fights and stuff.

But traditional forms are not made for actual fighting. Even though they're called Chinese boxing, Shaolin boxing, whatever, they're not for actual fighting. They're more for strengthening while doing the long hours of meditation and training. You understand what I'm saying? That's why they look beautiful, but they're more dense. They're not really martial in that sense.

Now, the weapon stuff, you can definitely use. Oh, yeah. I was doing *Hokushin Ittō-Ryū* with Sato Sensei from Japan, who was on our security team; he was a fourth degree in *Hokushin Ittō-Ryū*. That's live blade Japanese master. We used to spar all the time. I would do crazy Chinese *Wushu*, and I would get him. He'd get my 'ashtray', but I'd get his 'ashtray', too. OK? Because these are stuff that he did not see before. They come very different. You could definitely use them. And of course, the nice thing about Shaolin Kung Fu is they use weapons as a big part of the whole repertoire. It's like eighteen weapons. So, the whole weapons culture is different. That's really good for preparation for the Rod of Iron culture, because all of it is the same; it's just modernized technology. That's what the rifle is. It's just a modernized weapon.

Traditionally, Buddhist monks cannot use weapons or sharp-edged weapons or blades. They're supposed to be pacifists, and they can't kill anybody. But that's the unique thing about Shaolin, the monks actually had all the weapons, every type of technology that was available at the time. They used every type of crazy and insane weapons. You would never see any form of

Buddhism anywhere else, with the monks running around with weapons like that. You'd never see that anywhere in Thailand Buddhism, Burma Buddhism, Theravada Buddhism, Indian Buddhism. You'd never see that anywhere. It's so unique to China. It's so unique in the fact that it is a celebrated tradition.

Because during the medieval period in China, they had wars. And the monks were called demon staff, because they would whoop the warriors with just a wooden staff. "These monks, they have some mystical power; they're the demon staff, killing us with a stick". It just became legendary, so the emperor rewarded them. He allowed them the permission to have military weapons. It became actually like a military outpost. It was a temple, but it was like a military outpost.

So, it's such a wacky form of Buddhism, honestly speaking. It's such an anomaly in all the Buddhist world. There's nothing like that. You know what I'm saying? Because Buddhism is a meditative, passive tradition. Shakyamuni Buddha was not running around with a freaking halberd in his hand, running around with two Chinese swords. You never will see that anywhere else in the entire world of Buddhism, but China.

Preparation for the Rod of Iron Kingdom

But think about it: for the Rod of Iron Kingdom, what a GREAT preparation. It's the ONLY form of Buddhism that completely has not only normalized weapon, but celebrates it as their heritage. Oh my gosh! I never heard of anything like that. So, for the future, when China gets liberated from the CCP, becomes a free country and becomes a Rod of Iron Kingdom, what a great foundation that is. Because now all the monks can go from the spears and bows and halberds to the pew-pew.

And we'll train them; we'll train them! We'll do cross training with them. Our young people can go training in the weapons and they come train with us in the Rod of Iron Kingdom. Wonderful! Then the commies can't come up again, right? It's such a unique form, but again, what a great preparation.

The Shaolin Church vs. the Shaolin Communist Abbot

So, in that whole region, we're known as the martial arts church too, just as we are in the West. We're known there because I'm posting all this stuff about the Shaolin Temple. I'm an old grandpa here, running around, jumping around with halberds and stuff like that. I'm posting that. So, when we're evangelizing and meeting people, "Oh yeah, yeah, we do the training and this and that. We have the jujitsu, but we have the training for the young kids and that". And we became known as the Shaolin Church.

Because I actually trained at Shaolin, too. And I'm trying to get my Shifu too; I'm trying to find the guy, but I can't get into China right now. But I'm trying to get Dechao Sinim Shifu" (师父), to

come back and somehow maybe he can help us be on the martial arts board for the training. You know what I'm saying? That would be great; that would be wonderful. He was one of the, real monk generation. He's 34th generation. He said I'm 35th, even though I trained with him for three weeks. You know, it's so ridiculous. But he was the last generation before the Chicoms came in and then put in **Shi Yongxin**, who was a total fraud, total fake. He was the abbot.

This is how incredible this is: True Father's Kinship goes to China. We're doing the prayer condition. And we're starting up the Kung Fu training for the young kids. That is a good witnessing tool and good evangelism tool. We even did the lion dance. I never did that, but we just learned the lion dance with the local folks, and we incorporated all that heritage into the whole thing. The Chinese people love it, especially the older folks that come and they see that. And the young kids, they love it when they see the lions jump in. Our young people are doing the sword, and they're doing the monk staff and all that. Those boys also, we train them. We shave their heads. And they train two hours a day in a morning. They do the true love spinal cord meditation training. And they're doing martial art training.

So, they're like, "Dang, man! These guys are like, dang!" So, the local Chinese people, they really can connect with that. They really respect that. They kind of know we're a Korean church, but they're like, "Oh, how does your head abbot have all this Chinese stuff? He's training you into Shaolin, he's teaching you Kung Fu, and you're doing the lion dance. But also, you do jujitsu and MMA. It's weird. It's kind of unique". So, they're like, "This is quite interesting. "We were putting out this kind of prayers and training. And of course, after, we showed them, "Free China, Free China", things like that.

Unbelievable, unbelievable! The fake abbot Shi Yongxin was in there almost twenty years, ever since I was at Shaolin. All the monks were telling me, "That's a fake abbot; that's a communist abbot." They all hated him because they knew he was a communist. He was not a real monk. He was just doing the visuals for the CCP. His name was Shi Yongxin. Everybody knew he was fake. Everybody knew he was a communist politician. who was just walking around like a monk. The real monks hated him, and he actually pushed the real monks out to the back side. That's why I did training with Dechao Sinim in the back side.

Anyways, the point is: while we go to China, we're doing the prayer conditions, etc., and then doing the Kung Fu training and putting that stuff up, the Shaolin Temple blows up from the inside. Shi Yongxin, is totally disgraced. His career is done. He's now no longer the abbot. He had massive scandals where because he's a CCP official, basically, he has multiple children with multiple women, all this stuff; exactly what the monks were telling me twenty years ago. And it blows up. When does that blow up? It blows up EXACTLY at the time that we are in China and doing the Kung Fu training. Then, the Shaolin blows up. And now they have a new abbot in there who has been ordained thirty years. So, he's kind of a real one, and he's more of a scholar.

Shi Yongxin was a CCP plant who tried to use Shaolin's legendary heritage to promote the CCP worldwide. He was a businessman. He actually incorporated Shaolin as a business and then exported it worldwide to basically make a positive view of the CCP worldwide. But of course, behind the scene, he was having babies with all these hoes. And he's supposed to be a monk? That's a BAD MONK! He needs some Iron Groin Training.

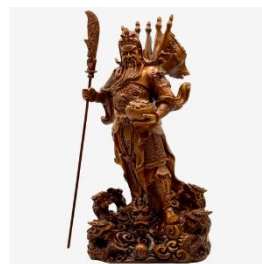

General Guang Gong & Daoism



This other one (top right), this is **General Guang Gong** of the Warring States period. I don't actually know a lot about him, but even in Taiwan, he is the law enforcement and military god. But he's basically the god of war; he's been deified. He was an actual general who's been deified into a god.

If you go into the temples in Taiwan, you will see Buddhas, you will see Lao Tzu, which is Daoism. Daoism is strong. In the West, people don't think of Daoism as an organized religion. They just think it's like Taiji practice. No, it's really organized. There are many sects of Daoism. I didn't actually know that. I was never interested in Daoism, really. I focused more on Buddhism. I was going to do my PhD in those comparative studies between John of Damascus and Huayan Buddhism. The point is, in China, there is big organized Daoism, a very big power block. I never expected that one. So, they'll have the Daoist deities and the Buddhas. And then they'll have **Guang Gong**; they'll have that general with the big beard and the halberd.

(Bottom right) And then the other one, this is **Guanyin Pusa**. Anyways, it's a long story with her. She basically becomes feminized as she comes from India. In traditional Buddhism, women cannot become enlightened. Yeh! You had to be reborn as a man to be enlightened. The Buddha did not even allow nunneries. These Western people don't know anything about Buddhism. Seriously, the nunneries were not allowed in the beginning. There are stories in Buddhism where the women were begging, "Please, we want to follow the Buddha, we want to be a nun".

So, he gave a special permission. But he said, “But you have to be reborn as a man to reach enlightenment”.

So anyways, the Guanyin looks like a woman, right? But in Sanskrit, the name is Avalokiteśvara. It's a male. It's a male bodhisattva. When it came into China, it got tied in with different existing female deities and it became more and more feminine. It became more feminine. You will see in some iconography she looked like that, but other times she looked like a woman, and she got a little mustache. Like some of the folks in the West nowadays, huh? Golly! What is going on? What is going on? You know what I'm saying?

In Fo Guang Chan, one of the big temples, they have the big thousand-arm Avalokiteśvara Guanyin. She looks like a woman standing there, but then there's her little mustache. Because they're supposed to transcend male and female. Of course, that's a dangerous ideology.



Now the Westerners say, “Hey, wait a minute, that sounds familiar now. What is that?” It sounds like Ishtar, doesn't it? The cult of Ishtar. Transgenderism, all this kind of thing. Although it obviously was not like the cult of Ishtar, which was actually like a sex cult. They had sexual parades. Buddhism is not like that. It's a monastic tradition, so it doesn't have that kind of focus. It sees all those things as very bad. So, obviously, it's more conservative. But the point is, when Avalokiteśvara came up from China, it looked more like a woman. Those are like the many, many icons that are in that landscape.

Now, do people see these and they actually worship them and stuff like that? No. They just believe there's something mystical and something powerful, some type of spirit realm that is lofty behind it. And honestly speaking, the Chinese people, and I would say Koreans in general before Christianity, they were just pagans in general. What do pagans worship? They worship money, right?

I mean, look at the urban kids, man. They're pagan. They worship money, too. “Y'all gotta get that money. I want money, money, money”. Young kids, they worship money, money, money, money. “Y'all gotta get that money.” So, it's not so different, actually. Any of the pagan lands will start worshipping money. And we're gonna get into why that is. From the God system point of view, it's actually very simple. It's very, very simple.

But the point is that God did not only come for the chosen people, He also met the Samaritan woman. So, it's very important for God's people that we have the heart of God. We hate the CCP. We hate what the Chinese oppressive system is, but we don't hate the Chinese people. We've got nothing against them. We want them to be free. We want them to be in the Kingdom, to see the fruits of the Kingdom.
