Expanded Hours for Walk-in Mammograms at ARC Medical Imaging

Special walk-in 3D mammogram screening events will be held in both September and October at ARC Medical Imaging in Canfield and Columbiana. Convenient access to mammograms is important for early breast cancer detection and treatment.

The expanded evening walk-in hours will be offered at ARC's two Medical Imaging locations:

- September 30 from 4-7 p.m. in Canfield, 5002 Millennial Lane at the corner of Route 224 and Palmyra Road
- October 2 from 4-7 p.m. in Columbiana, located in Suite 101 on the ground floor of the SRMC Surgery and Outpatient Pavilion at Firestone Farms, 400 Town Center Avenue

As a special treat, the first 30 patients who complete a mammogram at either location during the screening events from 4-7 p.m. will receive a complimentary dish of ice cream courtesy of the "Totally 80s Ice Ice Cream Shoppe" of Salem and Austintown.

ARC Medical Imaging is an independent diagnostic testing facility and a service of Salem Regional Medical Center (SRMC).

Salem Regional Medical Center currently offers walk-in 3D mammograms from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Monday-Friday at both ARC locations; and from 9 a.m.-2 p.m. Monday-Friday at SRMC's Medical Imaging Department, main campus.

SRMC is committed to bringing easily accessible healthcare to local communities and helping women fight breast cancer at its earliest stages through advanced 3D mammogram screenings. 3D mammograms provide sharper images, leading to better and earlier detection of breast abnormalities.

The 3D mammogram technology at ARC Medical Imaging's Columbiana and Canfield locations and SRMC's main campus is accredited by the American College of Radiology, which is the gold standard for facilities providing the highest level of image quality and safety.

According to Peter Apicella, M.D., Medical Director of ARC Medical Imaging and SRMC Chief Radiologist, "3D mammography can detect up to 40% more invasive cancers than a traditional mammogram. In addition, the overall radiation dose of the 3D examination is 30% less."

"Our 3D units feature the widest-angled acquisition method, which provides the greatest depth resolution and clarity of images, unlike other older 3D mammogram equipment. This level of detail greatly enhances the ability to quickly and more accurately identify early cancers, especially in women with dense breasts and fibrocystic breast disease, where tumors are more difficult to find."

For those who need further treatment, SRMC's breast imaging team works in tandem with the specially trained physicians at University Hospitals Seidman Cancer Center (UHSCC) at SRMC to offer comprehensive care and the latest advancements for helping patients overcome breast cancer and other breast conditions.

Imaging Services in Canfield and Columbiana

ARC Medical Imaging-Canfield offers expanded diagnostic medical imaging services beyond 3D mammograms including CT scans, ultrasounds and digital x-rays; with walk-in availability for mammograms and digital x-rays during normal business hours.

In addition to the services provided at ARC's Canfield site, ARC Medical Imaging-Columbiana also offers 3T MRIs and DEXA bone density scans. Patients can walk-in to ARC's Columbiana site during regular hours for mammograms, DEXA scans and digital x-rays.
