FAQ

What is Supper for Six?

Supper for Six is a great way to meet people from church and get to know one another a little better. Each group plans its own meals and gets together three times over three consecutive months. You share these meals at your homes, local restaurants or anywhere your group decides. The emphasis is not on cooking or hosting skills, but on fun and relationship building.

How does Supper for Six work?

Sign up in the church lobby or online. Fall groups will be set up in the first week of September. Each group will have a coordinator that contacts members to arrange the details of the first gathering. Groups are encouraged to collaborate and be creative with the meals enjoyed together.

What does a coordinator do?

This is the point person for a group. The coordinator contacts members to set the location, date and details for the first gathering.

Who cooks the meals?

Many groups opt for potlucks. Usually, the host makes the main dish and other participants bring sides or dessert. Potlucks are a good way to simplify meal planning and distribute costs among everyone in the group. Some groups may prefer to visit local restaurants and leave the cooking to the professionals.

What if I don't have room to host and I really, REALLY can't cook?

We hope everyone will feel that they can participate. If you absolutely can't host in your home, get creative and meet somewhere else. Can't cook? Grab a pizza or pick up a rotisserie chicken from the market. Outsource the cooking if that's easier, but please don't allow cooking or hosting to intimidate you. The treasure will be in getting to know each other.

How are the Supper for Six groups formed?

Our aim is to create groups of six adults, with the preferences each person has shared in mind. The assignments will depend on who signs up. The mystery is part of the fun!

What about families with children?

Your group preference will determine the answer here. Your indication to participate in a kid-friendly group will be a primary consideration in your group placement.

What happens after our final supper?

At your last gathering, you may decide to sign up for another season of Supper for Six with a new group of people or your group may wish to stay intact and continue as a small group. If you choose to stay together as a small group, Pastor Matt would be happy to provide resources to help you add elements of study and/or service as you continue to deepen the fellowship you have established.
