



TUITION, MATERIALS, TECHNOLOGY AND FEES

Annual Early Education Nido & Monarch: 18 months to 5 years old	\$5,900
Annual Elementary Education Kindergarten to 4th grade	\$8,650
Annual Middle School Education 5 th grade – 8 th grade	\$9,150

SLEEPY TOWN & BUSY TOWN - for Nido and Monarch Students

These programs begin at 12:30pm and ends at 3:00pm each day school is in session. Sleepy Town is for children still napping and Busy Town is for children who are no longer napping. The cost is \$12.50 per day or \$2,000 to enroll for the entire year.

PAYMENT PLANS:

- Plan A: Tuition is paid in full by August 1st to receive a 2.5% discount.
- Plan B: Tuition is split into two payments. 50% due August 1st and 50% due January 20th
- Plan C: Tuition is divided into ten monthly payments beginning in August and ending in May. All accounts must be set up for automatic tuition drafts. Two (2) sources of payment are required.

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due upon enrollment and is deducted from your tuition balance.

TUITION ASSISTANCE:

- GCS is a Hope Scholarship approved Education Service Provider. Hope Scholarship is the state's education savings account program that gives parents an opportunity to build an individual learning experience that works best for their child. The scholarship allows K-12 students to receive financial assistance that can be used for tuition. The Hope Scholarship application portal is available and open to new applicants.
