



TUITION ASSISTANCE GUIDELINES

Greenbrier Community School has a strong commitment to tuition assistance, which is based on our belief that a community of students from a wide range of socioeconomic backgrounds enhances the educational experience of all students. A portion of funds raised each year through our Annual Auction are set aside for tuition assistance. Tuition Assistance requests are reviewed by the GCS Finance Committee who strives to ensure diversity of the student population and that the full rewards of school choice are accessible to all families.

CONSIDERATIONS:

Since we are a small, non-profit school, we have a limited amount of tuition assistance to offer each year. The Tuition Assistance award is made by considering many factors that play into the committee's final award decision including:

- Family Resources: assets and discretionary spending.
- Divorced and Separated Parents: GCS requires the income of both parents on the SSS application as we are unable to subsidize tuition if one of the parents is capable, but unwilling, to contribute to tuition.
- Payment History: Enrollment contracts clearly state that all tuition must be current or paid-in-full before the child can enroll for the upcoming school year or a family can be considered for tuition assistance. Please see the student handbook for further information.

No family is offered 100 percent tuition assistance. The majority of Tuition Assistance awards are between 10 and 25 percent, with limited exceptions made. Tuition Assistance applications are submitted to School and Student Services for Financial Aid (SSS), a third party, by the National Association of Independent Schools.

HOPE SCHOLARSHIP

Greenbrier Community School is an approved Education Service Provider of the Hope Scholarship.

The Hope Scholarship is West Virginia's education savings account program offered through the West Virginia Treasurer's Office. This scholarship gives parents of eligible children the opportunity of school choice. The Hope Scholarship allows eligible K-12 students to receive annual financial assistance for approved schools. The Hope Scholarship application portal is available and open to new applicants.

New Hope Scholarship Applicants can apply beginning March Annually.
