



## **ONLYFANS & THE SEX TRADE**

"90% of the buyers we interviewed shared that they subscribed to content on OnlyFans." One said "It wasn't doing it for me anymore, so I decided to do this in person."

OnlyFans is a platform where creators sell subscriptions to their content, primarily pornographic, under the guise of a safe, empowering way to earn income. In reality, most creators make little money, while many face violent and disturbing demands from subscribers.<sup>2</sup> Behind the paywall, predators and traffickers operate with alarming ease.3

Despite the platform's assurances of moderation, it sells child sexual abuse material and footage of rape. OnlyFans is a stepping stone to sex buying, normalizing on demand personalized sexual content. OnlyFans ultimately reflects the broader dynamics of the sex trade: men's demand for paid sex fuels an exploitative system—both on and offline.

## THE REALITY OF CREATING CONTENT

The title of a video on OnlyFans: "Slutty collared submissive whore ... Gagging drooling and deepthroating . . . until she cries. Covered in degrading writing and dirty talking about how much of a dumb slut she is."1

"I'd sometimes collapse, and I wanted to die—but I'd always go back. ... you subconsciously accept humiliating, despicable, exploitative and abusive situations—rape in every sense." 1

## **CHILD ABUSE & TRAFFICKING**

US Special Agent investigating child abuse online estimates he finds

20-30 child abuse images a week originating from OnlyFans.4

A Reuters investigation identified 128 cases with complaints to U.S. law enforcement agencies that sexual images of them were sold on OnlyFans without their permission between 2019 and 2023.°
