The STOP CSAM Act must pass this Congress. Here's why:

EMPOWERS SURVIVORS TO SEEK JUSTICE

- 1** Creates a new federal civil right of action allowing victims to sue platforms that knowingly host, promote, or fail to remove CSAM. Survivors deserve their day in court.

CLOSES SECTION 230 LOOPHOLES

- 2** Narrows platform immunity under Section 230 for companies that knowingly facilitate the distribution of CSAM. Platforms can no longer hide behind blanket legal protections when they fail to act.

STRENGTHENS REPORTING & TRANSPARENCY

- 3** Requires platforms to submit annual transparency reports on CSAM detection and removal. Mandates faster reporting to the CyberTipline so law enforcement can rescue children quickly.

SUPPORTS VICTIMS THROUGH THE LEGAL PROCESS

- 4** Authorizes \$25 million for guardians ad litem to represent child victims in federal court and \$15 million for restitution trustees to help survivors collect court-ordered compensation.
