- March 2 - **Moving Manure Further** – The benefits and challenges to moving manure to fields further from the storage using satellite storages, frac tanks, pipelines and other strategies. Join panelists Glen Arnold OSU, Sean Barnes Eusi farms, Gerard Steenbeek, Stonecreek Farms and Martin Roelands (OPACA)
- March 9 - **Manure and Cover Crops** – Laura Van Eerd, Woody Van Arkel and Ken Schaus will share new research and on-farm experiences providing insight to the potential nutrient contributions, and soil health benefits from various cover cropping systems.
