### How your children will assessed

- > Children assessed against National Curriculum Year Group objectives
- > Assessment using:
  - Work
  - Observations
  - Guided group work
  - Individual and guided reading sessions
- > First assessment letter sent home at the end of Autumn term (December)



#### What you can do at home to help?

- > Practise saying the alphabet in order
- > Counting forwards and backwards in Is
  - Starting from 0 or any other number
- > Talking about events during the day/week using words such as: before, after, yesterday, tomorrow, next, then, etc.
- > Keep a diary to practise handwriting and spelling
- > Read as much as possible
- Attend 'Reward Assemblies' on a Wednesday morning if your child has received Citizen or Learner of the week, where you can applaud them receiving their certificates.



### Class Dojo



- > Will be continued to be used as the main form of communication to parents, outside of the weekly bulletin.
- > Teachers will use it as a means of contacting individual families as and when is needed.
- Class Dojo will not be used as a means for the children to 'Show and Tell' activities outside of school as the crammed Year I timetable does not allow time for this. We send home 'Proud Clouds' for the children/parents to complete to communicate achievements outside of the classroom (bit like the 'WOW' leaves sent home in Reception).
- > Parents can use the messaging facility if they need to contact teachers directly.
