After School Club Activities

Teacher club activities will begin for this term from next Monday 19th January. Please assume that your child(ren) will be able to go to the club requested unless you hear otherwise.

Please remember to advise the **school office** if your child will not be attending any of their sessions, as we take registers and need to follow up on unexplained absences and this sometimes-lengthy process could cause a delay identifying a child who might genuinely be missing.

At the end of the club, children will be brought to the door by their activity teacher, in order to be handed over individually to their adult. Parents/carers are asked to wait outside please, until their child is brought to them.

This arrangement is in place to ensure the security of all children in school during activities, to ensure a proper handover from staff to parents and to minimise disruption to activities still in progress. If you wish your Year 5 or 6 child to leave the club unaccompanied, for example to walk home or to meet a parent/carer waiting elsewhere, please inform the school so that we can let the teacher know this arrangement (and fill out the necessary forms available from the office).

Morning Clubs

Please can we remind parents/carers bringing children to morning clubs, that they should stay with their child and wait **outside** the school office until the coach is ready to collect them from you. Clubs start at **8.00am** and children should not be arriving any earlier. Thank you.

Outdoor PE

A reminder that the children will be taking part in outdoor PE lessons at least once a week so please ensure they have a plain black, grey or green tracksuit (no logos/stripes) or similar as part of their PE kits during these colder months. Shorts still need to be included as well.

Bicycles and Scooters on school premises

Please can I remind all parents/carers that scooters and bikes are not to be ridden once inside the school gates. Please ensure your child knows to dismount and walk their scooters/bikes to the cycle shelters. Thank you for your co-operation.
