Since 59 of its counties have less than 10 dentists each, Arkansas ranks in the bottom five of all states for dental visits. In addition, Arkansas residents consume sugar-sweetened beverages at one of the highest rates in the country.

Engaging the Community to Spread Oral Health Awareness

The Arkansas Oral Health Zone is a statewide

initiative that works with local schools, community

organizations, and health professionals to break the cycle of pediatric dental disease, especially in uninsured and underserved kids.

We work to increase the number of children who

receive preventative dental services, and ensure that they are connected to a dental home.

We collaborate with other health organizations to

provide oral health education in order to reduce
