Dear brothers and sisters,

How would you answer the question, 'what is God like?' How well do you know God?

"'Let not the wise boast of their wisdom, or the strong boast of their strength, or the rich boast of their riches, but let the one who boasts boast about this: that they have the understanding to know me, that I am the Lord, who exercises kindness, justice and righteousness on earth, for in these I delight,' declares the Lord." (Jeremiah 9:23–24)

The heart and glory of Christianity is *knowing God* – for through Christ, us sinful creatures may be forgiven and brought into true, deep, personal, life-changing relationship with God. And the Scriptures call us to be growing in our knowledge of God our Saviour: "...live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, *growing in the knowledge of God...*" (Colossians 1:10). Like orphans adopted into a new family getting to better know their new parents, so we – by grace adopted to sonship through Christ (Eph 1:5) – now get to better know our Heavenly Father, and his Spirit and his Son.

So, in quarter 3 this year in our sermons we plan to delve more deeply into this topic, each week looking at one of God's attributes – "God is..." - for example, "God is all-present" (today), eternal (next week), loving, holy, and so on. If one of the great temptations is to 'make God in our own image', how important it is that we allow God to reveal who he is to us. And how wonderful that he has done so, pre-eminently through Christ, "the image of the invisible God" (Col 1:15).

As we get to better know Almighty God, it will be mind-stretching. But this must not be a mere intellectual exercise. Please join me in praying that as we grow in our knowledge of who God is, we will grow in our personal relationship with God; in our awe and joy-filled worship of God; and in living lives which are conformed more to the likeness of Christ, in the power of his Spirit.

"Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent." (John 17:3)

MISSION PROJECT UPDATE Information for your Prayers



Bible Society

In Big Kids Sunday School recently we discussed how the good news of Jesus' death and resurrection could go to 'the ends of the earth' as Jesus commanded. Some suggested they go themselves and we discussed the need to learn a different language in order to share the good news. Then someone suggested sending them bibles, but they needed to be translated into other languages, so we talked about the work of the Bible Society here and overseas.

The Bible Societies have teams made up of speakers of the language plus others knowledgeable in bible language who work together with Bible Society's consultants to translate the bible into other languages. It's an exacting process.

"I told my sister. 'I'm not good at translating in Iwaija". Serina recalls. "Then she encouraged me, 'Well, if God is giving you this work, he's ahead of you and he will direct you." Serina was one of many who gathered in Darwin for a Bible translator's workshop at Nungalinya College in November 2024. This workshop saw nearly 50 translators from 16 different language groups represented.

In 2024, Bible Society Australia and Wycliffe Bible Translators collaborated to establish a state-of-the-art video recording studio to produce Auslan Bible resources for the Australian Deaf community.
