Knowing God: God Un-Needful

Welcome to St Mark's today.

We're continuing in our topical series on 'Knowing God' and today get to the truth that God is Un-Needful. We are dependent on God and others, but God is perfectly independent – God does not depend on us, or any other thing. God is self-existent, and self-sufficient.

Here is how JI Packer helpfully reflects on this truth:

Children sometimes ask, "Who made God?" The clearest answer is that God never needed to be made, because he was always there. He exists in a different way from us: we, his creatures, exist in a dependent, derived, finite, fragile way, but our Maker exists in an eternal, self-sustaining, necessary way—necessary, that is, in the sense that God does not have it in him to go out of existence, just as we do not have it in us to live forever. We necessarily age and die, because it is our present nature to do that; God necessarily continues forever unchanged, because it is his eternal nature to do that. This is one of many contrasts between creature and Creator... In our life of faith, we easily impoverish ourselves by embracing an idea of God that is too limited and small...

The Triune God of the Bible is not *needy*. For all eternity past before the creation of the world, the Father and Spirit and Son existed in perfect love and glory and life. God did not create the world or humanity because he needed us, or our fellowship, or our love, or worship! In contrast, we need God. As Paul says, "The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples built by human hands. And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything. Rather, he himself gives everyone life and breath and everything else." (Acts 17:24-25)

God does not need us, but we do need God. We depend on God for our existence, our provision, and salvation. In Christ, God the Son – in very nature glorious and un-needful God – became incarnate as a needy human being and gave his life on the cross for sin and has been raised as Saviour of all – because we need him to work salvation for us. Paul asks the Corinthians, "what do you have that you did not receive?" (1 Cor 4:7). We need our un-needful God – and he is pleased to grant salvation to all who call on his name.
