VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE

October 13, 2026 (by mail or online)

ELECTION DAY

Tuesday, November 3, 2026
Polls open 6 am – 8 pm

VOTE-BY-MAIL

**Any eligible registered voter can
Vote-By-Mail in NJ after applying.**

To get your Vote-By-Mail Ballot in the mail, apply online or mail an application which must be received by your County Clerk **by October 27, 2026.**

You can apply and get a Vote-By-Mail Ballot in-person at your County Clerk **until 3 pm on November 2, 2026.**

THREE VOTING OPTIONS

IN-PERSON ON ELECTION DAY

Vote in-person at your polling location

November 3, 2026 from 6 am – 8 pm

Find your polling location at lwvnj.org/vote

IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING

Vote using a voting machine at early voting polling locations.

October 24 – November 1, 2026

10 am – 8 pm weekdays & Saturdays

10 am – 6 pm Sundays

VOTE-BY-MAIL

Return your ballot one of three ways

- **Secure Drop Box:** Use a secure drop box in your county by 8 pm on Election Day.
- **Board of Elections Office:** Bring your ballot in-person to your County Board of Elections by 8 pm on Election Day.
- **By Mail:** Ballot must be postmarked by Election Day. Due to a recent change, USPS considers mail postmarked when it is *processed*, not when it is received. If you choose to mail your ballot, do so at least several days before Election Day.
