YOU HAVE A VOTING DECISION TO MAKE!

If you're a NJ resident heading out of town or out of state for college, you have a decision to make before Election Day.

Register to vote using your home address OR register to vote using your new campus residence address.

Option A: Register at Home Address

Vote for officials and issues impacting your hometown. Return home to vote in-person during early voting or on Election Day OR Vote-by-Mail from college.

- 1 Register to vote / check your voter registration status:** Visit Vote.NJ.Gov.
- 2 Decide how to vote:** Vote411.org has poll locations and sample ballots. For a Vote-by-Mail ballot sent to your college address, apply at Vote.NJ.Gov.

Option B: Register at New College Address

Vote for officials and issues impacting your college town and campus community. Remember to change your registration if you move or after you graduate.

- 1 Register to vote / re-register to vote at your college address:** Visit Vote411.org for information about registering to vote.
- 2 Know how to vote at your new address:** State voting laws, requirements, and deadlines vary. Check Vote411.org and make sure you're ready!
