**WHEREAS**, John Newton served as a parish curate in the City of Olney's Sister City of Olney, Buckinghamshire, England; and

**WHEREAS**, through his life and ministry, John Newton exemplified a profound transformation and used his voice to advocate for the abolition of slavery, leaving an enduring mark on both spiritual and social history; and

**WHEREAS**, John Newton was born on July 24, 1725, and July 24, 2025, will mark his 300<sup>th</sup> birthday; and

WHEREAS, the City of Olney, Illinois, wishes to honor the life and contributions of John Newton, acknowledging the powerful impact of his work on faith, music, and human rights; and

**WHEREAS**, the week of July 20-Juy 26, 2025, marks an opportunity to reflect on and celebrate the values of grace, redemption, and justice that John Newton championed.
