Resolved: Cllrs Rodden and Rowland

RS25/9/2: Declarations of interests on items on the agenda

Resolved: No declarations of interest were received.

RS25/9/3: To approve the minutes of the meeting held on 14th July 2025

Resolved: Cllr Hillier proposed, Cllr Bethune seconded that the minutes of 14th July be approved, all in favour.

RS25/9/4: To receive an update on the ex-football club building

Resolved: It was noted from the Full Council meeting that the updated Padel proposal be approved to progress to planning permission.

RS25/9/5: To consider planting the Cherry Orchard at the Allotment Field

Resolved: The site was agreed as appropriate. The additional report noted that the acorns, descended from Cowper's Oak, were being distributed for planting during this year of significant anniversaries.

RS25/9/6: To consider benches along Aspreys and High Street

Resolved: Clerk to engage with MKCC for permission to install benches at sites to be agreed.
