Curious Thinking: asking questions and learning about sea turtles




# See God's Story:


# **Storyline:**

practice stewarding His creation.






# **Storyboard:**









## **Throughlines:**

#### **Creation Care**

Students will practice creation care by picking up trash at a local beach community in order to conserve the environment. They will gain a deeper understanding of the impact their actions have on creation and will grow their appreciation for it.

## **Community Building**

Students and parents will work together to restore the natural beauty of the beach at La Boquita.



## Formational Learning Experience:

**Real needs**: Plastic pollution in the community at La Boquita endangers sea turtles and other marine animals and takes away from the natural beauty of that area.

**Real people**: Sea turtle expert, local fisherman, and restaurant owner at La Boquita

Real work: Students will participate in a beach clean up.

We picked up trash at a beach and spent time enjoying God's creation.












