

Technology allows for significant task redesign

Technology allows for the creation of new tasks, previously inconceivable

Flipgrid

- What is it? an accessible video discussion platform that can be used to build a digital community.
- What can it do for my classroom? Video management and sharing, groups & topics, Google Classroom roster, captions & immersive reader.
- Where do I access it? <u>flipgrid.com</u>



How to use Flipgrid

- 1. Sign in (e.g. Google or Microsoft).
- 2. Create a topic or group.
- 3. Share link or code.



Flipgrid Applications pt. 1

 <u>Substitution</u> = Students reflect on the main idea of the day with a short video response.

 <u>Augmentation</u> = Students record and merge multiple video clips to create a daily journal.



Flipgrid Applications pt. 2

 Modification = Students record a book review, print out a QR code, and attach it to the cover of their book.

 Redefinition = Students post videos of them practicing a different language. Guest native speakers of that language give feedback and encouragement.
