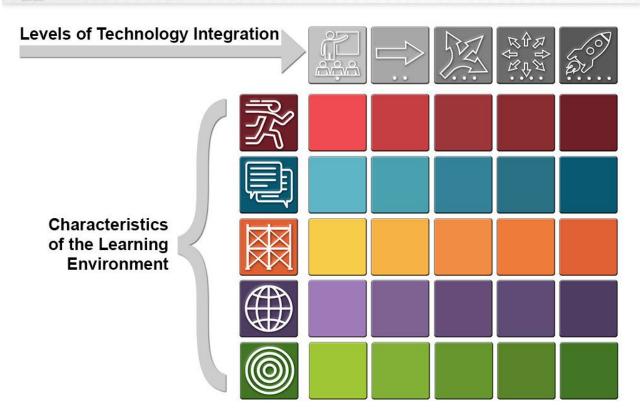
Book Creator Overview

- What is it? A tool with a limited, free account to make digital, multimedia books.
- How does it support engagement? Simple drag-and-drop design with templates, embed media and apps, reading and speech accessibility options, build and publish a library of student books, 1 library with 40 books limit.

Book Creator Applications

"Move up a level" using <u>Technology Integration Matrix</u>.

- Active "students are engaged in using the technology as a tool."
- Entry (passive use): <u>Teachers give</u> students books to read or listen to through Book Creator.
- Entry → Adoption (procedural use): Teacher models and directs students on how to add media, text, and files into their own books.
- Adoption → Adaptation (independent use): <u>Students choose</u> designs and templates to create a storybook while teachers facilitate and support.
