1.2 ISTE-S standard & Blogger

- **Communication**: students convey ideas through text, an image, or a video.
- Etiquette: students interact responsibly with others through comments.
- Rights & Responsibility: students can moderate comments or invite others to help them moderate.
- **Security & Privacy**: students protect their identity and data by being aware of what to post and who has access.

1.2 Sub-standards Overview

- 1.2a **Manage** their <u>digital identity</u>.
- 1.2b **Engage** in positive, safe, legal and ethical <u>behavior</u>.
- 1.2c **Demonstrate** <u>understanding and respect</u> for rights and property.
