This materials list consists of mandatory items, as well as optional items. Any additional materials that you already have in your artist's toolkit are always welcome. Suggested brand names are *'italicized'*. While all materials can be found at *Opus Art Supplies*, similar products and brands from other stores are welcome.

WHAT WE PROVIDE

- Easels, glass palettes, side tables, chairs & stools, containers for liquids, masking tape, and saran wrap.

PENCIL & ERASER

- 2B pencil + one 'kneaded' eraser

PAINT

Oils are recommended, although acrylics or water-based oils are also welcome.

- Titanium White
- Cadmium Yellow Light (*or Medium*)
- Yellow Ochre
- Cadmium Red Medium
- Alizarin Permanent Crimson
- Ultramarine Blue
- Burnt Sienna
- Raw Umber
- Ivory Black

NOTE: It is recommended to use 'artist grade' vs. 'student grade' paint. Affordable brands include Holbein, Gamblin, Winsor & Newton (not Winton), Opus Essentials, or Kama Oil paint (Rath Art Supplies), as well as Rembrandt (DeSerres). More expensive brands are welcome too.

MEDIUM

FOR OILS:

- Refined Linseed Oil: bring one small bottle (*any brand*).
- *Gamblin's 'Gamsol'* odourless mineral spirits (*one small bottle*). Please do not bring other brands or turpentine.
- Bring an extra glass jar + lid to store excess dirty OMS after class.

FOR ACRYLICS:

- Small spray bottle for water, to keep your paint wet.
 - Optional: Acrylic '*Retarder*' to extend drying time for acrylics.
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BRUSHES

Please bring a range of shapes & sizes, and whatever brushes you enjoy working with.

Garrett recommends the following long-handled brushes:

- 2 Synthetic Filberts (*any sizes between 4, 6 and 8*)
 - 1 Filbert, Bright or Flat (*any size between 10 and 12*)
 - 2–3 Synthetic Rounds (*any sizes between 6–8*)
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GESSO

- Acrylic White '*Gesso*' (*small bottle*) for surface preparation (*see below*).
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SURFACE

- Bring one surface: 12" x 16"
 - '*Gessoed hardboard panel*' is preferred (*aka 'Artboard' or 'Ampersand'*).
 - Alternatively canvas board or stretched canvas are welcome.
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SURFACE PREPARATION

- Your surface requires a total of 3 layers of gesso.
 - Surfaces with white gesso already included, please add 2 more layers, allowing to dry between layers.
 - Try to minimize the texture by using a soft, wide brush (*like 3" or wider*) and gently fan out the brush strokes. A little texture is fine.
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PALETTE KNIFE

- We recommend the *'Liquitex' Small Painting Knife #5*.
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PALETTE

OILS:

A glass palette is provided, although you are welcome to bring your own.

ACRYLICS: (Optional)

It is recommended to use a *'Masterson Sta-Wet'* palette (16" x 12").

This palette keeps your acrylics wet throughout the day.

PAPER TOWELS & RAGS

- Bring one roll of *'Scott's Shop Towels'* (*blue*). Found at any commercial painting and lumber stores. * [link to material](#) (*click to open*)
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SKETCHBOOK

- Optional: 8.5" x 11" (*or smaller*) for taking notes.
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CLOTHING

- Painting can be messy, please bring suitable clothing.
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GLOVES (optional)

- While Painting: Latex or '*Guerilla Grip*' gloves (*breathable + waterproof*)
 - Brush Cleaning: Waterproof rubber gloves are recommended.
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OPTIONAL

- Mahl stick
- Paint '*Razor*' Scraper (*to clean & organize your glass palette*).
