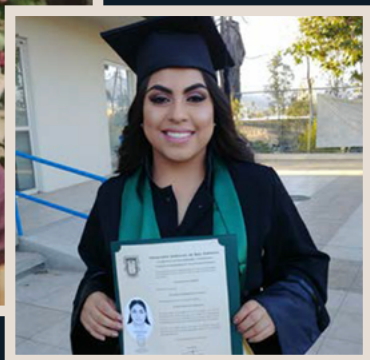

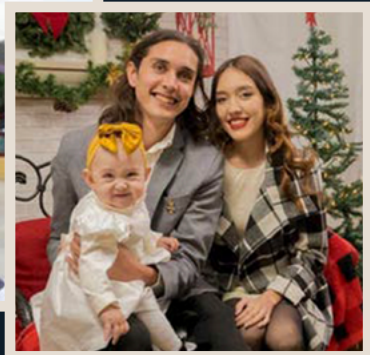
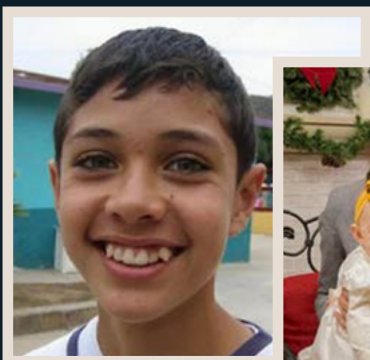
BREAKING THE CYCLE – ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

WE STAND FOR CHANGED LIVES



We are a for-purpose organization providing life changing support for orphaned and abandoned children in Baja, Mexico. We are on a mission to end child abandonment by breaking the vicious cycle of poverty.

PROBLEM

The issue of child abuse, neglect and abandonment is a world wide issue. According to the UN over 150 million children are abandoned and living on the streets worldwide. In Mexico's Northern Baja region, over 6,000 children live on the streets or under dangerous/abusive situations, and thousands more live in extreme poverty. Mexico does not have the social programs like foster care or a welfare system. The only way to support children in need is through a network of private orphanages, funded entirely through individual and corporate donations.

SOLUTION

Corazón de Vida (CDV) is a 30 year US 501(c)(3) non-profit organization providing lifechanging support for orphaned and abandoned children in Baja, Mexico by funding local orphanages, providing quality of life improvement services and investing in the children's future by funding higher education.

SUSTAIN

Monthly funding for our orphanages.
Covering food, shelter, water, and utilities,
the basic survival needs.

EDUCATE

Funding for uniforms, supplies, graduation fees,
and scholarships for teens aging out of the
orphanage system.

Project based funding for facilities

and psychological services.
