We Stand For Changed Lives

We are a for-purpose organization providing life-changing support for children without family-based care in Baja, Mexico. We are on a mission to break the vicious cycle of poverty.

THE PROBLEM

Child abuse, neglect, and abandonment are worldwide issues. According to the UN, over 150 million children are abandoned and living on the streets worldwide. In Mexico's Northern Baja region, over 6,000 children live on the streets or under dangerous and abusive situations, and thousands more live in extreme poverty. Mexico does not have social programs such as foster care or a welfare system. The only way to support children in need is through a network of private group homes, funded entirely through individual and corporate donations.

THE SOLUTION

Corazon de Vida (CDV) is a 32-year-old US 501(c)(3) non-profit organization providing life-changing support for children living in alternative care in Baja, Mexico, by funding group homes, providing quality of life improvement services, and investing in the children's future by funding higher education.



SUSTAIN

Monthly funding for 10+ group homes. Covering food, shelter, water, and utilities. The basic survival needs.



IMPROVE

Project based funding for facilities improvement, construction, medical, dental, and psychological services.



EDUCATE

Funding for uniforms, supplies, graduation fees, and scholarships for teens aging out of the system of group homes.
