

2026 Southern Idaho Aphid Monitoring Network, Week 35

Aphid monitoring is winding down for 2026, with monitoring ending today for about a third of the sites where adjoining fields are completely dead. Monitoring for all sites will cease September 14. Overall, the number of winged aphids captured per trap so far this year (weeks 23-35) was lower (15.3 winged aphids per trap) compared to 2025 (21.6 aphid per trap).
