



## Atlas Dining Table

Named after the mythical Titan condemned to hold up the heavens on his shoulders, the solid legs of the Atlas table stand strongly as support for the spacious tabletop. The meeting and contrast between the legs and the tabletop is central to the design, where each element exaggerates the other giving the table its distinct presence and brutalist feel. For Atlas, John Astbury has taken inspiration from several influences in architectural history. There are references to porticoes and colonnades, but Atlas builds mainly on the archetypal post-and-lintel construction. Combined with simple geometry, the circle and the square, it is the primary archetypes that together create the table's character and composition. The Atlas Dining Table claims its place in the dining room with its solid, well-crafted expression and enchants everyone, from the small to the large party, who gathers around it.

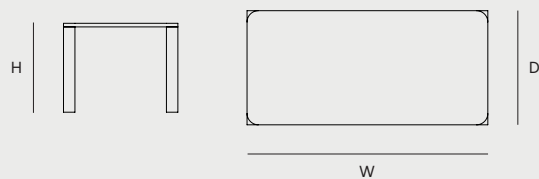
<b>Material</b>	The Atlas tables are crafted from solid oak wood. They come in either a natural oak or a traditionally fumed oak finish. The tabletop's slim profile is achieved through a hidden c-channel construction.

<b>Cleaning &amp; Care</b>	Use a soft, dry cloth to remove the dust from the table. For deeper cleaning, dampen a cloth gently wipe the surface. If needed, use a mild detergent. Always test a small area first to ensure it does not damage the finish. After cleaning, use a dry cloth to wipe away moisture, since moisture can damage the material.
