


HB Coffee Table

Variants

Available in two wood finishes—Oiled Oak and Fumed Oiled Oak.

Materials, Process and Finishing

Crafted from solid oak wood using traditional joinery techniques, each table is hand-assembled for lasting strength and quality. Surfaces are sanded by hand in gradual steps for a smooth, tactile feel, and finished with a hand-applied clear oil to enhance durability while preserving the wood's natural character and repairability.

Fumed Oak Process

For a deeper tone, the oak undergoes a traditional fuming process, where it is exposed to a small amount of ammonia vapors in a sealed environment for 20 hours. This reaction with the wood's natural tannins enhances the grain structure and deepens the color. As a natural, non-surface-based treatment, no dyes are used, preserving the wood's authentic character. Variations in hue may occur depending on the tannin content of each piece.

Craftsmanship Statement

We support and foster the Danish cultural heritage of craftsmanship by preserving and advancing the traditional techniques nurtured in our family workshop since 1886. This commitment reflects both the preservation of the craft and its evolution through the integration of new techniques, innovation, and design development.

Description

The HB Coffee Table by Brdr. Krüger is a refined tribute to Hans Bølling's iconic 1963 tray table, reimagined for contemporary living. Its minimalist, circular form embodies the essence of Danish design: simplicity, functionality, and enduring beauty. Designed in partnership with the American Hardwood Export Council, the collection highlights the unique hues and rich natural beauty of the wood. The design emphasizes the material's inherent beauty, resulting in a timeless piece meant to be cherished for generations.
